~~PROPOSED~~ **TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

This matter coming before the Court for hearing on Plaintiffs Supermax, Inc. and Glovepaq Manufacturing, LLCs' Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining Order ("Motion"), with reasonable notice having been given, the ~~parties~~ ^{Plaintiffs} having appeared through counsel, ^{and Defendants not appearing} and the Court having considered the Verified Complaint for Injunctive and Other Relief, heard the arguments of counsel, and been fully advised in the premises, the Court finds that:

Clearly Ascertainable Right

1. Glovepaq Manufacturing, LLC ("Glovepaq Manufacturing") and Supermax, Inc. ("Supermax"), its majority member, have established their clearly ascertainable right to control of the Glovepaq Intellectual Property. "Glovepaq Intellectual Property" as defined and hereafter referenced in this Order shall mean and refer to:

a. The following three (3) U.S. Registered Trademarks:

- (1) Glovepaq (Serial No. 78/768,835);
- (2) Quick-Cuff (Serial No. 77/280,330); and

(3) Cuff First (Serial No. 77/489,098).

b. The following five (5) U.S. Patents:

(1) Patent No. 7,063,233, issued June 20, 2006, for an invention entitled Method of Folding Gloves and Dispenser Therefor;

(2) Patent No. 8,132,692, issued March 13, 2012, for an invention entitled Method of Folding Gloves and Dispenser Therefor;

(3) Patent No. 6,901,723, issued June 7, 2005, for an invention entitled Method of Folding Gloves and Dispenser Therefor;

(4) Patent No. 7,874,455, issued January 25, 2011, for an invention entitled Dispenser and Gloves; and

(5) Patent No. 8,061,558, issued November 22, 2011, for an invention entitled Dispenser and Gloves.

c. The following three (3) foreign patents:

(1) EU Patent No. 1534594

(2) EU Patent No. 2216252

(3) China Patent No. ZL 02829429.7

d. U.S. Patent Application No. 13/501,679

Likelihood of Success on the Merits

2. Glovepaq Manufacturing and Supermax have raised a fair question that Defendant Earl Jordan improperly caused the assignment of the Glovepaq Intellectual Property to Defendant Jordan Fund LLC, without the authority or consent of Supermax, and in direct breach of the Joint Venture/Shareholders

Agreement between Supermax and Jordan Fund LLC and in violation of Delaware law.

3. Glovepaq Manufacturing and Supermax have raised a fair question that Defendant Jordan Fund LLC's acceptance of the assignment of the Glovepaq Intellectual Property breached the Joint Venture/Shareholders Agreement between it and Supermax

Irreparable Harm

4. Glovepaq Manufacturing and Supermax, its majority member, have established that they will suffer irreparable harm to the business operations, business reputation, goodwill, and competitive position of Glovepaq Manufacturing, if Earl Jordan and Jordan Fund LLC are permitted to further assign or license the Glovepaq Intellectual Property to any third party.

Lack of Adequate Remedy at Law

5. Due to unique nature of the Glovepaq Intellectual Property and the unquantifiable losses in revenue, reputation, goodwill and competitive advantage that would be caused by the loss of the Glovepaq Intellectual Property, Glovepaq Manufacturing and Supermax will have no adequate remedy at law for the irreparable harm suffered.

6. Glovepaq Manufacturing and Supermax have satisfied their burden for entry of a temporary restraining order, maintaining the status quo, under 735 ILCS 5/11-101.

For these reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

a. Defendants Jordan Fund, LLC and Earl Jordan, and all persons or entities acting in concert with them, are hereby temporarily enjoined and prohibited from making any assignment, sale or license whatsoever of any or all of the Glovepaq Intellectual Property, as that term is defined herein, to any third party, *as of 9:30am CDT on Oct. 6, 2014.*

b. *Plaintiff's are granted expedited*
~~A preliminary injunction hearing is set for _____, _____,~~
discovery, returnable on Oct. 15, 2014.

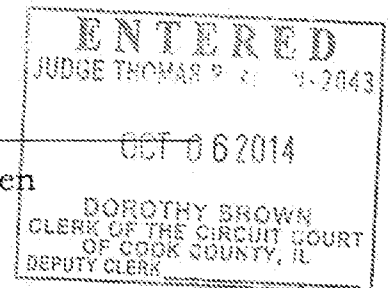
