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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, OMS Investments, Inc., a Delaware corporation having offices at 10250 Constellation Blvd., Suite 2800, Los Angeles, California 90067 ("ASSIGNOR") owns all right, title and interest in and to the IP Assets (defined below); and

WHEREAS, Global Harvest Foods, Ltd., a Washington corporation having offices at 16000 Christensen Road #300, Tukwila, Washington 98188 ("ASSIGNEE") is desirous of acquiring ASSIGNOR's entire right, title and interest in and to the IP Assets;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, ASSIGNOR's entire right, title and interest in and to the IP Assets.

"Business" means the business of manufacturing and selling wild bird food in the United States conducted by ASSIGNOR and its Affiliates Gutwein & Co., Inc. and The Scotts Company LLC as of March 21, 2014 through their facilities located in Reynolds, Indiana and Doland, South Dakota.

"Excluded IP Assets" shall have the meaning set forth in Schedule 2 attached hereto.

"Intellectual Property" means (a) trademarks, service marks, trade names, brand names, corporate names, logos, trade dress or other source identifiers or indicia of goods or services, whether registered or unregistered, and all registrations and applications for registration of such, including intent-to-use applications, all issuances, extensions and renewals of such registrations and applications and the goodwill connected with the use of and symbolized by any of the foregoing; (b) internet domain names, whether or not trademarks; registered in any top-level domain by any authorized private registrar or Governmental Authority; (c) original works of authorship in any medium of expression, whether or not published, all copyrights (whether registered or unregistered), all registrations and applications for registration of such copyrights, and all issuances, extensions, restorations, reversions and renewals of such registrations and applications; (d) all know-how, trade secrets, and confidential or proprietary information, however documented and in whatever form, whether in writing, orally, electronically, optically, magnetically, or otherwise, including, without limitation, product specifications, data, charts, know-how, manufacturing know-how, formulae, confidential statements of formula, compositions, processes, designs, sketches, photographs, graphs, drawings, samples, inventions and ideas, past, current and planned research and development, current and planned manufacturing or distribution methods and processes, past, current or planned manufacturing methods, processes, equipment, materials, training, controls, or quality, customer lists, current and anticipated customer requirements, price lists, market studies, business plans, client and customer lists and files, historical, current and projected sales, capital spending budgets and plans, business plans, strategic plans, marketing and advertising plans, and publications; (e) patented and patentable designs and inventions, all design, plant and utility patents, letters patent, utility models, pending patent applications and provisional applications and all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations and renewals

of such patents and applications; (f) any and all computer programs, including operating system and applications software, implementations of algorithms and program interfaces, whether in source code or object code form, databases and all documentation relating to the foregoing, including user manuals relating to the foregoing, in each case whether owned or licensed; and (g) all rights to sue and recover and retain damages, costs and attorneys' fees for past, present and future infringement and any other rights relating to any of the foregoing.

"IP Assets" means the Intellectual Property owned by ASSIGNOR that is primarily related to the Business including without limitation the trademarks listed in Schedule 1(a) attached hereto, the patents and patent applications listed in Schedule 1(b), and the domain name listed in Schedule 1(c), but excluding the Excluded IP Assets identified in Schedule 2. ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNEE intend that the definition of "IP Assets" as used herein be the same as the definition of "Purchased Intellectual Property" used in the Asset Purchase Agreement ("APA") dated March 21, 2014 between ASSIGNOR, ASSIGNOR's Affiliates, and ASSIGNEE.

ASSIGNOR hereby covenants that it has the full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that it has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict with this Intellectual Property Assignment.

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees to execute without further consideration any further documents and instruments which may be necessary, lawful and proper to secure to ASSIGNEE its interest and title in the aforementioned IP Assets.

ASSIGNOR hereby further covenants and agrees that it will communicate to ASSIGNEE any and all facts known to it respecting said IP Assets, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute and deliver all papers and take any actions that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to any of the IP Assets.

ASSIGNOR does hereby authorize and request the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office and directors of equivalent foreign intellectual property offices, to issue any and all letters patent, trademark registrations, or similar rights which may be granted upon said IP Assets, or any parts thereof, when granted, to said ASSIGNEE.

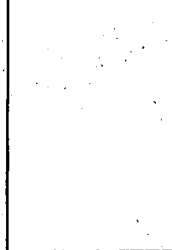


