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## FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT

THIS FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT (this "Release") is made and entered into this 5th day of February, 2015, by U.S. BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION ("Lender"), in favor of CHARTER NEX FILMS, INC., formerly known as American Plastics Company, Inc. and successor by merger with New England Extrusion Inc., a Wisconsin corporation, and CHARTER NEX HOLDING COMPANY, formerly known as NEX Performance Films Inc., a Delaware corporation (the "Borrowers").

To the extent, if any, that following the release as set forth above, Lender retains or would retain any right, title or interest in or to the Collateral, including the patents on Schedule A, patent applications on Schedule B, trademarks and service marks on Schedule C and trademark applications on Schedule D (the "Specified Collateral") or, with respect to the patents and patent applications, any inventions and improvements described and claimed therein and reissues, divisionals, provisionals, continuations and continuations-in-part, reexaminations, renewals, substitutions and extensions thereof and amendments thereto and, with respect to the trademarks, service marks and trademark applications, any goodwill of any business conducted in connection therewith, Lender hereby reassigns, grants and conveys to Borrower, without any representation, warranty, recourse or undertaking by Lender, all of Lender's right, title and interest in, to and under the Specified Collateral, and the goodwill of Borrower's business connected with the use of and symbolized by the Specified Collateral.
