TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT (this "Assignment") is made effective as of October 24, 2012 ("Effective Date") by C&D Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 1400 Union Meeting Road, Blue Bell, Pennsylvania 19422-0858 ("Assignor") to Crown Battery Manufacturing Company, an Ohio corporation with its principal place of business at 1445 Majestic Drive, Fremont, Ohio 43420-0990 ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor owns the marks set forth on the attached "Schedule A" and the goodwill of the business symbolized by and associated with those marks in Canada, Mexico, and the United States (these three countries comprising "the Territory"), which marks were embodied by registrations in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and, for two of the marks, in Canada and Mexico (the marks collectively referred to as "the Marks");

WHEREAS, Assignor has agreed to sell, assign, transfer, convey, grant, and deliver to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title, and interest in, to, and under the Marks in the Territory; and

WHEREAS, Assignee desires to acquire from Assignor all of its right, title, and interest in, to, and under the Marks in the Territory.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration as set forth in a separate agreement between the parties entitled "Trademark And Know-How License Agreement" and dated October 24, 2007, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers, conveys, grants, and delivers to Assignee all of Assignor's respective right, title, and interest in, to, and under the Marks, together with the goodwill associated therewith, including all registrations, applications, and common law rights therefor in the Territory, including any renewals and extensions of the registrations that are or may be secured under the laws of the United States, Canada, and Mexico, now or hereafter in effect, for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of Assignee's successors, assigns, or other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this assignment had not been made, together with all income, royalties, or payments due or payable as of October 24, 2012 or thereafter, including, without limitation, all claims for damages by reason of past, present, or future infringement or other unauthorized use of the Marks, with the right to sue for and collect the same for Assignee's own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns, or other legal representatives.

2. Assignor covenants and agrees that it will, upon the reasonable request of Assignee, execute and deliver, or cause to be executed or delivered, any and all documents provided by Assignee that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the assignment, conveyance, and transfer of the Marks under this Assignment.

3. This Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania applicable to agreements made and to be performed entirely

within such Commonwealth, without regard to the conflicts of law principles of such Commonwealth.

4. This Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, all of which shall be considered one and the same agreement, and shall become effective when one or more such counterparts have been signed by each of the parties and delivered to the other party.
