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## ASSIGNMENT

And Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States and any official of any foreign country whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as described above, to issue all letters patent in the Assigned Intellectual Property and emanating from the Assigned Intellectual Property to Assignee, its successors and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this assignment;

And Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States to issue all trademark registrations and renewals which may issue with respect to the Assigned Intellectual Property to Assignee, its successors and assigns, in accordance with this assignment.

And, Assignor hereby covenants that Assignor has not and will not execute any agreement in conflict with this assignment.
