TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("**Trademark Assignment**"), dated as of November 10, 2015, is made by Law Enforcement Technology Group, Inc. ("**Assignor**"), in favor of Law Enforcement Technology Group, LLC ("**Assignee**").


NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers and assigns to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to: (i) U.S. Trademark Registration No. 3259339 (LETG) in International Class 9 for "computer software, namely software for use in database management by law enforcement agencies"; (ii) issuances, extensions and renewals of such registration; and (iii) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor, including any and all causes of action, accruing under any of the foregoing provided by any applicable law of any jurisdiction throughout the world (collectively, the "**Assigned Trademark**"), together with the goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, the Assigned Trademark.
2. Recordation and Further Actions. Assignor authorizes the Commissioner for Trademarks of the USPTO and any other national, federal and state government officials to record and register this Trademark Assignment upon request by Assignee. Assignor shall execute any and all documents and take all other further actions as reasonably requested by Assignee to transfer ownership of the Assigned Trademarks.
3. General.
 - (a) Entire Agreement. This Trademark Assignment constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings and agreements, both written and oral, with respect to such subject matter.
 - (b) Successors and Assigns. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
 - (c) Governing Law. All matters arising out of or relating to this Trademark Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the internal laws of the State of Minnesota without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule.
 - (d) Counterparts. This Trademark Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this Trademark Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-mail or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Trademark Assignment.
