TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

THIS TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT, effective *nunc pro tunc* as of October 30, 2015, is made by and between Hamilton Products, Inc. d/b/a Hamilton Stands (the “*Assignor*”) and U.S. Band & Orchestra Supplies, Inc. d/b/a/ St. Louis Music, (the “*Assignee*”);

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of federal trademark applications and registrations and common law unregistered marks, as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto, including the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby and associated therewith, (the foregoing referred to as the “*Marks*”);

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee are parties to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated October 30, 2015, which transferred certain assets of Assignor to Assignee, including several pending intent-to use trademark applications set forth on Exhibit A, and including the business or the portion of Assignor’s business, which is ongoing and existing, with which the marks of the intent-to use trademark applications are to be used; and,

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the Marks, and of recording its status as owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the Marks;

NOW, THEREFORE, for the good and valuable consideration as set forth herein, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignor does hereby assign, transfer and convey to Assignee all its right, title and interest in and to the Marks, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby, together with all applications and/or registrations thereof, together with a right to sue for and collect on all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement of said Marks.

2. Assignor does hereby assign to Assignee the marks in U.S. Trademark Application No. 86/488,811 UMIKOA and U.S. Trademark Application No. 86/488,824 WORLD STAGE, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the trademark. These applications are being assigned as part of the entire business or portion thereof to which the mark pertains, as required by Section 10 of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1060.


3. Assignor agrees to take whatever further action is deemed necessary or appropriate by Assignee to properly and fully effect and perfect the transfer to Assignee of the Marks, to establish full custody of the Marks by Assignee, to set forth and establish the chain of title to the Marks, and to set forth and establish the first use of the Marks. For example, without limitation, Assignor agrees to execute assignments to Assignee regarding the Marks as may be required in proceedings throughout the world.

4. This Assignment Agreement shall be governed by the internal laws of the State of Missouri, without reference to its conflicts of law principles.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Assignment Agreement by and through their properly authorized signatories effective as of the date indicated above.


