FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

THIS FULL RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST (this "Release") is made and entered into as of the 28th day of December, 2015, by Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, a national banking association ("Wells Fargo") in favor of Triad Manufacturing, Inc., a Missouri corporation with an address of 4321 Semple Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63120 (the "Borrower").

Background

A. Pursuant to that certain Patent and Trademark Security Agreement, dated as of December 31, 2012, by and between Wells Fargo and Borrower (the "Security Agreement"), a security interest (the "Security Interest") was granted by Borrower to Wells Fargo in certain collateral, including the Trademarks and Patents (as defined in the Security Agreement);

B. The Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on January 16, 2013 at Reel/Frame 4944/0168.

C. Wells Fargo now desires to terminate and release its Security Interest in the Trademarks and Patents.

Agreement

Wells Fargo hereby terminates, discharges, and releases any security interest it may have in the Trademark and Patent Collateral.

(a) The term "Trademark Collateral" as used herein shall mean:

all of Company's right, title and interest in and to (i) trademarks, service marks, collective membership marks, registrations and applications for registration for each, and the respective goodwill associated with each, (ii) licenses, fees or royalties with respect to each, (iii) the right to sue for past, present and future infringement, dilution and damages therefor, and (iv) licenses thereunder, all as presently existing or hereafter arising or acquired, including, without limitation, the marks listed on Schedule A.


(b) The term "Patent Collateral" as used herein shall mean:

all of Company's right, title and interest in and to patents or applications for patents, fees or royalties with respect to each, and including without limitation the right to sue for past infringement and damages therefor, and licenses thereunder, all as presently existing or hereafter arising or acquired, including without limitation the patents listed on Schedule A.
