ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS
AND ACCOMPANYING GOODWILL

THIS ASSIGNMENT is made and effective as of the 31st day of December, 2015, (hereinafter the "Effective Date"), by and between R. E. Schaub Enterprises, Inc., a Michigan corporation, whose principal address is Suite 4, 4740 Talon Court SE, Grand Rapids, Michigan 49512, (the "Assignor"), and Emtex Products, Inc., a California corporation, whose principal address is 15250 E. Stafford Street, City of Industry, California 91744, (the "Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of all rights, title and interest in and to the trademarks SCHAUB and SCHAUB & Design, and the registrations therefor in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the Canadian Intellectual Property Office as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, (collectively, the "Trademarks"), the goodwill of the business associated therewith and symbolized thereby, and all rights appurtenant thereto, including, but not limited to, all common law rights, causes of action and the right to recover for past infringement, dilution or other misappropriation thereof; and

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the Trademarks and all goodwill associated therewith and symbolized thereby and all rights appurtenant thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which Assignor acknowledges by its execution below:

1. Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers and assigns to Assignee all of its rights, title and interest in and to the Trademarks, including without limitation the registrations therefor, together with the goodwill of the business connected with the use of and symbolized by said Trademarks,

and together with any and all rights appurtenant to said Trademarks, including without limitation (a) all common law rights therein; (b) all contractual rights respect to any and all of the foregoing, including without limitation all and licenses and similar rights granted by Assignor to any third party any and all royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect thereto; and (c) any and all interests, claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on or after the Effective Date hereof, including without limitation all rights to and claims for damages and profits, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief by reason of any past, present or future infringement, dilution, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, unauthorized use and all other related causes of action, with the right but not the obligation to sue for such legal and/or equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages, related to the Trademarks.

2. Assignor agrees to perform all reasonable and proper additional acts and to execute any additional documents at the request and expense of Assignee which Assignee may require in order to transfer all of Assignor's rights, title and interest in and to the said Trademarks and all rights appurtenant thereto, to Assignee, its successors or assigns.

3. This Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-mail or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Assignment.


4. This Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.


