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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("**IP Assignment**"), dated as of January 22, 2016, is made by Silicon Graphics International Corp. ("**Assignor**"), a Delaware corporation, located at 900 North McCarthy Blvd, Milpitas, CA, in favor of Mineset Inc. ("**Assignee**"), a Delaware corporation, 900 North McCarthy Blvd., Milpitas, CA, pursuant to a Contribution Agreement between Assignor and Assignee, dated as of January 22, 2016 (the "**Principal Agreement**").

Whereas, under the terms of the Principal Agreement, Assignor has conveyed, transferred and assigned to Assignee certain trademarks, copyrights and other intellectual property of Assignor, and has agreed to execute and deliver this IP Assignment, for recording with government authorities including, but not limited to, the US Patent and Trademark Office ("**USPTO**").

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers and assigns to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the following (the "**Assigned IP Rights**"), together with the goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, the trademarks within the Assigned IP Rights:

(a) The trademarks, trademark registrations and trademark applications set forth on Schedule 1 hereto and all issuances, extensions and renewals thereof (the "**Assigned Trademarks**"); provided that, only with respect to United States intent-to-use trademark applications, the transfer of such applications accompanies the transfer of the portion of Assignor's business to which such trademarks pertain, and that business is ongoing and existing;

(b) registrations of the internet domain names set forth on Schedule 3 hereto, whether or not incorporating Assignor's trademarks, registered to Assignor in any generic top level domain by any authorized private registrar or governmental authority;

(c) all licenses and similar contractual rights with respect to any of the foregoing granted by Assignor to any third party;

(d) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing under any of the foregoing provided by any applicable law of any jurisdiction throughout the world; and

(e) any and all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on or after the date hereof, including all rights to and

claims for damages, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present and future infringement, dilution, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.

2. Recordation and Further Actions. Assignor authorizes the Commissioner for Trademarks of the USPTO, the Register of Copyrights, and any other national, federal and state government officials to record and register this IP Assignment upon request by Assignee. Assignor shall execute any and all documents and take all other further actions as reasonably requested by Assignee to transfer ownership of the Assigned IP Rights. Disclaimers. Except as expressly provided herein, Assignor makes no representations, warranties, covenants, agreements or indemnities, and hereby disclaims all implied warranties, with respect to the validity of, or Assignor's or Assignee's ability to use, register or enforce the Assigned IP Rights.

The terms of the Principal Agreement, are incorporated herein by this reference. The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that any representations, warranties, covenants, agreements and indemnities contained in the Principal Agreement shall not be superseded hereby but shall remain in full force and effect to the full extent provided therein. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the terms of the Principal Agreement and the terms hereof, the terms of the Principal Agreement shall govern.

3. General.

(a) Entire Agreement. This IP Assignment, together with the Principal Agreement, other agreements incorporated therein by reference and all related exhibits and schedules, constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter contained herein and therein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous understandings and agreements, both written and oral, with respect to such subject matter.

(b) Successors and Assigns. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.


(c) Governing Law. All matters arising out of or relating to this IP Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the internal laws of the State of California without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of California or any other jurisdiction).

(d) Counterparts. This IP Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same agreement. A signed copy of this IP Assignment delivered by facsimile, e-

mail or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this IP Assignment.


