INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (this "<u>Agreement</u>"), dated as of February 11, 2016, by and among (a) QS Wholesale, Inc. and the other Persons identified on <u>Schedule I</u> hereto (individually, a "<u>Grantor</u>", and collectively, the "<u>Grantors</u>") and (b) BANK OF AMERICA, N.A., a national banking association, as administrative agent (in such capacity, the "<u>Agent</u>") for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Credit Parties (as defined in the Credit Agreement referred to below), in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and benefits to be derived herefrom.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, reference is made to that certain Credit Agreement, dated as of February 11, 2016 (as amended, amended and restated, modified, supplemented or restated and in effect from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), by and among, *inter alia* (i) QS Wholesale, Inc., as the Lead Borrower, (ii) Quiksilver Canada Corp., as the Canadian Borrower, (iii) Ug Manufacturing Co. Pty Ltd, as the Australian Borrower, (iv) the other Borrowers from time to time party thereto, (v) the guarantors from time to time party thereto (individually a "Guarantor") and, collectively, the "Guarantors"), (vi) the lenders from time to time party thereto (individually, a "Lender" and, collectively, the "Lenders"), and (vii) Bank of America, N.A., as Administrative Agent, Collateral Agent, Swing Line Lender and L/C Issuer, pursuant to which the Lenders have agreed to make Loans to the Borrowers, and the L/C Issuer has agreed to issue Letters of Credit for the account of the Borrowers, upon the terms and subject to the conditions specified in the Credit Agreement;

WHEREAS, reference is also made to that certain Guaranty, dated as of February 11, 2016 (as amended, amended and restated, modified, supplemented or restated and in effect from time to time, the "Guaranty"), executed by the Guarantors in favor of the Agent pursuant to which each Guarantor guarantees the payment and performance of the Guaranteed Obligations (as defined in the Guaranty); and

WHEREAS, the obligations of the Lenders to make Loans and of the L/C Issuer to issue Letters of Credit are each conditioned upon, among other things, the execution and delivery by the Grantors of (i) that certain Security Agreement, dated as of February 11, 2016 (as amended, amended and restated, modified, supplemented or restated and in effect from time to time, the "Security Agreement"), by and among the Grantors and the Agent, pursuant to which each Grantor grants to the Agent (for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Credit Parties) a security interest in and to the Collateral (as defined herein), and (ii) an agreement in the form hereof, pursuant to which each Grantor grants to the Agent (for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Credit Parties) a security interest in and to the IP Collateral (as defined herein), in order to secure the Secured Obligations (as defined herein).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual conditions and agreements set forth in this Agreement, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby

acknowledged, the Grantors and the Agent, on its own behalf and on behalf of the other Credit Parties (and each of their respective successors or assigns), hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions.

- 1.1 Generally. All references herein to the "UCC" shall mean the Uniform Commercial Code as in effect from time to time in the State of New York and all terms used herein and not otherwise defined herein or in the Credit Agreement shall have the meanings (if any) given such terms in the UCC; provided, however, that if a term is defined in Article 9 of the UCC differently than in another Article thereof, the term shall have the meaning set forth in Article 9; provided further that, if by reason of mandatory provisions of law, perfection, or the effect of perfection or non-perfection, of the security interest in any IP Collateral or the availability of any remedy hereunder is governed by the Uniform Commercial Code as in effect in a jurisdiction other than New York, "UCC" means the Uniform Commercial Code as in effect in such other jurisdiction for purposes of the provisions hereof relating to such perfection or effect of perfection or non-perfection or availability of such remedy, as the case may be.
- 1.2 <u>Definition of Certain Terms Used Herein</u>. Unless the context otherwise requires, all capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the Credit Agreement. In addition, as used herein, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Accession" shall have the meaning given to such term in the UCC.

"APPSR" shall have the meaning assigned to the term "register" in the Personal Property Securities Act 2009 (Cth) (Australia).

"<u>CIPO</u>" shall mean the Canadian Intellectual Property Office or any other governmental agency which may hereafter perform its functions.

"Collateral" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the Security Agreement.

"Copyrights" shall mean all copyrights in each work of authorship or derivative work thereof of any Grantor, whether registered or unregistered and whether published or unpublished, including, without limitation, the United States, Canadian and Australian copyright registrations and copyright applications listed on EXHIBIT A annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

"Copyright Licenses" shall mean all agreements to which a Grantor is a party, whether written or oral, providing for the grant by or to any Grantor of any right under any Copyright.

"Copyright Office" shall mean the United States Copyright Office or any other federal governmental agency which may hereafter perform its functions.

"Credit Agreement" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the preliminary statement of this Agreement.

"Excluded Assets" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the Security Agreement.

"Grantor" and "Grantors" shall have the meaning assigned to such terms in the preamble of this Agreement.

"Guaranty" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the preliminary statement of this Agreement.

"Industrial Designs" shall mean all industrial designs and applications for industrial designs of any Grantor, and the inventions, processes, designs and improvements therein disclosed, and any and all divisions, revisions, reissues and continuations, continuations-in-part, extensions, and reexaminations of said industrial designs including, without limitation, the United States, Canadian and Australian industrial design registrations and industrial design applications listed on EXHIBIT D annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

"<u>Industrial Design Licenses</u>" shall mean all agreements to which a Grantor is a party, whether written or oral, providing for the grant by or to any Grantor of any right under any Industrial Design.

"Intellectual Property" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in SECTION 3 of this Agreement.

"<u>IP Australia</u>" shall mean IP Australia or any other Australian Governmental Authority which may hereafter perform its functions.

"IP Collateral" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in SECTION 2 of this Agreement.

"<u>Licenses</u>" shall mean, collectively, the Copyright Licenses, Patent Licenses, Trademark Licenses, Industrial Design Licenses, and any other license providing for the grant by or to any Grantor of any right under any Intellectual Property.

"Patents" shall mean all patents and applications for patents of any Grantor, and the inventions and improvements therein disclosed, and any and all divisions, revisions, reissues and continuations, continuations-in-part, extensions, and reexaminations of said patents including, without limitation, the United States, Canadian and Australian patent registrations and patent applications listed on EXHIBIT B annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

"<u>Patent Licenses</u>" shall mean all agreements to which a Grantor is a party, whether written or oral, providing for the grant by or to any Grantor of any right under any Patent.

"<u>PTO</u>" shall mean the United States Patent and Trademark Office or any other federal governmental agency which may hereafter perform its functions.

"Proceeds" shall have the meaning given to such term in the UCC.

"Secured Obligations" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the Security Agreement.

"Security Agreement" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the preliminary statement of this Agreement.

"Security Interest" shall have the meaning assigned to such term in the Security Agreement.

"Trademarks" shall mean all trademarks, trade names, corporate names, company names, domain names, business names, fictitious business names, trade dress, trade styles, service marks, designs, logos and other source identifiers of any Grantor, whether registered or unregistered, including, without limitation, the United States, Canadian and Australian trademark registrations and trademark applications listed on EXHIBIT C annexed hereto and made a part hereof, together with any goodwill of the business connected with, and symbolized by, any of the foregoing.

"<u>Trademark Licenses</u>" shall mean all agreements to which a Grantor is a party, whether written or oral, providing for the grant by or to any Grantor of any right under any Trademark.

1.3 <u>Rules of Interpretation.</u> The rules of interpretation specified in Sections 1.02 through 1.11 of the Credit Agreement shall be applicable to this Agreement.

SECTION 2. Grant of Security Interest. In furtherance and as confirmation of the Security Interest granted by each of the Grantors to the Agent, its successors and assigns, (for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Credit Parties) under the Security Agreement, and as further security for the payment or performance, as the case may be, in full of the Secured Obligations, each Grantor hereby ratifies such Security Interest and grants to the Agent, its successors and assigns (for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Credit Parties) a security interest in all of such Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under the following property, whether now owned or now due, or in which any Grantor has an interest, or hereafter acquired, arising, or to become due, or in which any Grantor obtains any interest and all products, Proceeds, substitutions, Accessions of or to the following property (collectively, the "IP Collateral"):

- (a) All Copyrights and Copyright Licenses;
- (b) All Patents and Patent Licenses;
- (c) All Trademarks and Trademark Licenses;
- (d) All Industrial Designs and Industrial Design Licenses;

- (e) All other Licenses;
- (f) All renewals of any of the foregoing;
- (g) All trade secrets, know-how and other proprietary information; copyrightable works of authorship and other copyright works (including copyrights for computer programs); inventions (whether or not patentable) and all improvements thereto; industrial design applications and registered industrial designs; intellectual property rights in books, records, writings, computer tapes or disks, flow diagrams, specification sheets, computer software, source codes, object codes, executable code, data, and databases; and all other similar intellectual property and proprietary rights;
 - (h) [Reserved];
- (i) All income, royalties, damages and payments now and hereafter due and/or payable under and with respect to any of the foregoing, including, without limitation, payments under all Licenses entered into in connection therewith and damages and payments for past or future infringements, misappropriations or dilutions thereof;
- (j) The right to sue for past, present and future infringements, misappropriations, and dilutions of any of the foregoing; and
- (k) All of the Grantors' rights corresponding to any of the foregoing throughout the world;

provided, however, that the IP Collateral shall not include, and the Security Interest and the security interest granted hereunder shall not attach to, any Excluded Assets.

- SECTION 3. <u>Protection of Intellectual Property By Grantors</u>. Except as set forth below in this SECTION 3, each of the Grantors shall undertake the following with respect to each of the items respectively described in SECTIONS 2(a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) (collectively, the "<u>Intellectual Property</u>"):
 - (a) Pay all renewal fees and other fees and costs associated with maintaining the Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor and with the processing and prosecution of the Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor and take all other steps reasonably necessary to maintain each registration of the Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor, except, in each case, to the extent that such Intellectual Property is no longer used or useful in the conduct of such Grantor's business in any material respect.
 - (b) Take all actions reasonably necessary to prevent any of the Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor from becoming forfeited, abandoned, dedicated to the public, invalidated or impaired in any way, except, in each case, to the extent that such Intellectual Property is no longer used or useful in the conduct of such Grantor's business in any material respect.

- (c) At the Grantors' sole cost, expense, and risk, reasonably pursue the processing and prosecution of each application for registration owned by such Grantor which is the subject of the security interest created herein and not unreasonably abandon or delay any such efforts, except, in each case, to the extent that such Intellectual Property is no longer used or useful in the conduct of such Grantor's business in any material respect.
- (d) At the Grantors' sole cost, expense, and risk, take any and all action which the Grantors reasonably deem necessary or desirable under the circumstances to protect the Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor from infringement, misappropriation or dilution, including, without limitation, the prosecution and defense of infringement actions, except, in each case, to the extent that such Intellectual Property is no longer used or useful in the conduct of such Grantor's business in any material respect.
- SECTION 4. <u>Grantors' Representations and Warranties</u>. In addition to any representations and warranties contained in any of the other Loan Documents, each Grantor represents and warrants that:
 - (a) EXHIBIT A is a true, correct and complete list, as of the Closing Date, of all United States, Canadian and Australian Copyrights owned by such Grantor which are the subject of a registration or application for registration with the Copyright Office, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof).
 - (b) EXHIBIT B is a true, correct and complete list, as of the Closing Date, of all United States, Canadian and Australian Patents owned by such Grantor which are issued by or the subject of an application with the PTO, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof).
 - (c) EXHIBIT C, is a true, correct and complete list, as of the Closing Date, of all United States, Canadian and Australian Industrial Designs owned by such Grantor which are the subject of a registration or application for registration with the PTO, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof).
 - (d) EXHIBIT D, is a true, correct and complete list, as of the Closing Date, of all United States, Canadian and Australian Trademarks owned by such Grantor which are the subject of a registration or application for registration with the PTO, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof).
 - (e) Such Grantor owns, or is licensed or otherwise has the rights to use, all Intellectual Property reasonably necessary for the conduct of its business as currently conducted except as would not reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect.

As of the Closing Date, no claim has been asserted and is pending by any Person against such Grantor challenging the use by such Grantor of any of its Intellectual Property, or the validity or effectiveness of any of its Intellectual Property, that would reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect. To the knowledge of such Grantor, the use by such Grantor of the Intellectual Property does not infringe the rights of any Person, except, in each case, as would not reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect. As of the Closing Date, no holding, decision or judgment has been rendered by any Governmental Authority against such Grantor which would limit, cancel or challenge the validity of, or such Grantor's rights in, any Intellectual Property in any respect that would reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect.

(f) Such Grantor shall give the Agent prompt written notice, with reasonable detail, following the occurrence of a Responsible Officer of such Grantor's knowing that any application or registration relating to any Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor has, other than as provided in SECTION 3 above, become forfeited, abandoned or dedicated to the public, or of any adverse determination or development (including, without limitation, the institution of, or any such determination or development in, any proceeding in the PTO, the Copyright Office, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or any court or tribunal, other than routine office actions and similar developments) regarding such Grantor's ownership of, or the validity or enforceability of, any Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor or such Grantor's right to register the same or to own and maintain the same, for each of the foregoing, except to the extent that (i) such Intellectual Property is no longer used or useful in such Grantor's business in any material respect or (ii) any such forfeiture, abandonment, dedication, adverse determination or development would not reasonably be expected to result in a Material Adverse Effect.

SECTION 5. Agreement Applies to Future Intellectual Property.

(a) The provisions of this Agreement shall automatically apply to any ownership and other rights in and to additional Intellectual Property obtained by any Grantor after the date hereof, all of which shall be deemed to be and treated as "Intellectual Property" within the meaning of this Agreement (other than Excluded Assets). Within the time frames set forth in Schedule 6.02 to the Credit Agreement, each Grantor shall notify the Agent of any item of IP Collateral which is the subject of a registration or application with the PTO, the Copyright Office, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof) in which such Grantor obtained an ownership interest after the Closing Date (or, as the case may be, after the most recent notification pursuant to this SECTION 5) and during such Fiscal Year, and hereby authorizes the Agent to file, at such Grantor's expense, an updated Exhibit A, B and/or C (as applicable) to this Agreement with respect to such IP Collateral as set forth in SECTION 5(b).

- (b) Each of the Grantors shall execute and deliver, and have recorded, any and all agreements, instruments, documents and papers as the Agent may reasonably request to evidence the Agent's security interest in any Intellectual Property (including, without limitation, filings with the PTO, the Copyright Office, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof)), and each of the Grantors hereby constitutes the Agent as its attorney-in-fact to execute and file all such writings for the foregoing purposes, all such acts of such attorney being hereby ratified and confirmed; provided, however, that the Agent's taking of such action shall not be a condition to the creation or perfection of the security interest created hereby, provided further that no Grantor shall be obligated to take any such actions with respect to any Intellectual Property registered, applied for, or otherwise existing in any jurisdiction outside of the United States, Canada or Australia.
- SECTION 6. Grantors' Rights To Enforce Intellectual Property. Except while an Event of Default exists and until such time as the Agent provides notice to the contrary, the Grantors shall have the exclusive right to sue for past, present and future infringement of the Intellectual Property, including the right to seek injunctions and/or money damages in an effort by the Grantors to protect the Intellectual Property against encroachment by third parties, provided, however, that:
 - (a) The Grantors provide the Agent with written notice of the Grantors' institution of any legal proceedings alleging infringement of any Intellectual Property, to the extent such infringement would reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect.
 - (b) Any money damages awarded or received by the Grantors on account of such suit (or the threat of such suit) shall constitute IP Collateral.
 - (c) Upon the occurrence and during the continuance of any Event of Default, the Agent, by prior written notice to the Grantors, may terminate or limit the Grantor's rights under this SECTION 6.
- SECTION 7. <u>Agent's Actions To Protect Intellectual Property</u>. In the event of the occurrence and continuance of any Event of Default, the Agent, acting in its own name or in that of any Grantor, may (but shall not be required to) act in any Grantor's place and stead and/or in the Agent's own right in connection with any reasonable actions necessary to protect the Intellectual Property.
- SECTION 8. <u>Rights Upon Default</u>. Upon the occurrence and during the continuance of an Event of Default, in addition to all other rights and remedies under this Agreement and the other Loan Documents, the Agent may (and, at the direction of the Required Lenders, shall) exercise all rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as adopted in the State of New York, with respect to the Intellectual Property, in addition to which

the Agent may sell, license, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the Intellectual Property, subject to those restrictions to which such Grantor is subject under applicable Law and by contract. Any person may conclusively rely upon an affidavit of an officer of the Agent that an Event of Default has occurred and that the Agent is authorized to exercise such rights and remedies.

SECTION 9. Agent As Attorney-In-Fact.

- (a) Each of the Grantors hereby irrevocably makes, constitutes and appoints the Agent (and all officers, employees or agents designated by and acting on behalf of the Agent) as and for such Grantor's true and lawful agent and attorney-in-fact, and in such capacity the Agent shall have the right, with power of substitution for each Grantor and in each Grantor's name or otherwise, for the use and benefit of the Agent and the other Credit Parties:
 - (i) To supplement and amend from time to time EXHIBITS A, B and C of this Agreement to include any newly applied for, registered, or acquired Intellectual Property of such Grantor which is the subject of a registration or application with the PTO, the Copyright Office, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof) (other than Excluded Assets) and any intent-to-use Trademark applications for which evidence of use of such Trademark in interstate commerce use has been submitted to the PTO pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1051 Section 1(c) or 1(d).
 - (ii) Following the occurrence and during the continuance of any Event of Default, to exercise any of the rights and remedies referenced herein.
 - (iii) Following the occurrence and during the continuance of any Event of Default, to execute all such instruments, documents, and papers as the Agent reasonably determines to be necessary or desirable in connection with the exercise of such rights and remedies and to cause the sale, license, assignment, transfer, or other disposition of the Intellectual Property, subject to those restrictions to which such Grantor is subject under applicable Law and by contract.
- (b) The power of attorney granted herein, being coupled with an interest, shall be irrevocable until this Agreement is terminated in writing by a duly authorized officer of the Agent.
- (c) The Agent shall not be obligated to do any of the acts or to exercise any of the powers authorized by SECTION 9(a), but if the Agent elects to do any such act or to exercise any of such powers, it shall not be accountable for more than it actually receives as a result of such exercise of power, and shall not be responsible to any Grantor for any act or omission to act, except where a court of competent jurisdiction determines by final

and nonappealable judgment that the subject act or omission to act has resulted from the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Agent.

SECTION 10. <u>Agent's Rights</u>. Any use by the Agent of the Intellectual Property, as authorized hereunder in connection with the exercise of the Agent's rights and remedies under, and in accordance with, this Agreement, the Credit Agreement and the Security Agreement shall be coextensive with the applicable Grantor's rights thereunder and with respect thereto and without any liability for royalties or other related charges.

SECTION 11. <u>Intent</u>. This Agreement is being executed and delivered by the Grantors for the purpose of registering and confirming the grant of the security interest of the Agent in the IP Collateral with the PTO, the Copyright Office, the CIPO, IP Australia, the APPSR or other applicable Governmental Authority in the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof). It is intended that the security interest granted pursuant to this Agreement is granted as a supplement to, and not in limitation of, the Security Interest granted to the Agent, for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Credit Parties, under the Security Agreement. All provisions of the Security Agreement (including, without limitation, the rights, remedies, powers, privileges and discretions of the Agent thereunder) shall apply to the IP Collateral. In the event of a conflict between this Agreement and the Security Agreement (except for (i) Section 2.01 herein and the definition of IP Collateral (as defined herein) and (ii) Section 2.01 of the Security Agreement and the definition of Collateral (as defined therein)), the terms of this Agreement shall control with respect to the IP Collateral and the terms of the Security Agreement shall control with respect to all other Collateral.

SECTION 12. Further Assurances.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of clause (b) below, each Grantor agrees, at its own expense, to execute, acknowledge, deliver and cause to be duly filed all such further documents, financing statements, agreements and instruments and take all such further actions as the Agent may from time to time reasonably request to better assure, preserve, protect and perfect the security interest in the IP Collateral granted pursuant to this Agreement and the rights and remedies created hereby or the validity or priority of such security interest, including the payment of any fees and taxes required in connection with the execution and delivery of this Agreement, the granting of the security interest and the filing of any financing statements or other documents in connection herewith or therewith; provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein or in any other Loan Document, no Grantor shall be obligated to take any actions with respect to any Intellectual Property registered, applied for, or otherwise existing in any jurisdiction outside of the United States, Canada or Australia (including, in each case, any political subdivision thereof).
- (b) The Agent acknowledges that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, the Grantors are not required to take steps to perfect the Security

Interest in any IP Collateral of the Grantors registered outside of the United States, Canada and Australia (such IP Collateral, the "Foreign IP Collateral").

SECTION 13. Termination; Release of IP Collateral.

- (a) Any Lien upon any IP Collateral under this Agreement will be released automatically if such IP Collateral is being Disposed of in a Permitted Disposition (other than Permitted Dispositions described in clause (c) in the definition thereof) and, solely to the extent required by the Credit Agreement, upon receipt by the Agent of the Net Proceeds thereof. Upon at least two (2) Business Days' prior written request by a Grantor, the Agent shall execute such documents as may be necessary to evidence the release of the Liens upon any IP Collateral described in this SECTION 13(a) or to release any Subsidiary as described in Section 13(c); provided, however, that (i) the Agent shall not be required to execute any such document on terms which, in its reasonable opinion, would, under applicable Law, expose the Agent to liability or create any obligation or entail any adverse consequence other than the release of such Liens without recourse or warranty, and (ii) such release shall not in any manner discharge, affect or impair the Secured Obligations or any Liens (other than those expressly being released) upon (or obligations of any Grantor in respect of) all interests in the IP Collateral retained by any Grantor, including, without limitation, the Proceeds of any sale of the IP Collateral, all of which shall continue to constitute part of the IP Collateral.
- Except for those provisions which expressly survive the termination thereof, this Agreement and the security interest granted herein shall terminate when (i) the Aggregate Total Commitments have expired or been terminated, (ii) all of the Secured Obligations (other than contingent indemnification obligations for which claims have not yet been asserted) have been paid in full in cash or otherwise satisfied, (iii) all L/C Obligations have been reduced to zero (or fully Cash Collateralized), and (iv) the L/C Issuer has no further obligation to issue Letters of Credit under the Credit Agreement, at which time the Agent shall execute and deliver to the Grantors, at the Grantors' expense, all UCC termination statements, releases and similar documents that the Grantors shall reasonably request to evidence such termination; provided, however, that the Credit Agreement, this Agreement, and the security interest granted herein shall be reinstated if at any time payment, or any part thereof, of any Secured Obligation is rescinded or must otherwise be restored by any Credit Party upon the bankruptcy or reorganization of any Grantor. Any execution and delivery of termination statements, releases or other documents pursuant to this SECTION 13 shall be without recourse to, or warranty by, the Agent or any other Credit Party.
- (c) A Subsidiary shall automatically be released from its obligations hereunder and the security interest in the IP Collateral of such Subsidiary shall be automatically released upon consummation of any transaction permitted by the Loan Documents as a result of which such Subsidiary ceases to be a Subsidiary of Parent or becomes an Unrestricted Subsidiary, an Immaterial Subsidiary or an Inactive Subsidiary.

SECTION 14. <u>Governing Law</u>. THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY, AND CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH, THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK.

SECTION 15. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original but all of which, when taken together, shall constitute a single contract. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Agreement by facsimile or other electronic transmission shall be as effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart of this Agreement.

SECTION 16. <u>Headings.</u> Article and Section headings used herein are for convenience of reference only, are not part of this Agreement and shall not affect the construction of, or be taken into consideration in interpreting, this Agreement.

SECTION 17. <u>Intercreditor Agreement</u>. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the priority of the liens, security interests and pledges granted to the Agent for the benefit of the Credit Parties pursuant to this Agreement and the exercise of any right or remedy by the Agent hereunder are subject to the provisions of the Intercreditor Agreement. In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Intercreditor Agreement and the terms of this Agreement, the terms of the Intercreditor Agreement shall govern and control.

SECTION 18. <u>Recordation</u>. The Grantors hereby authorize and request that (i) the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and any other applicable United States government officer, (ii) the commissioner, registrar or any other applicable government officer of the CIPO, (iii), IP Australia, and (iv) the APPSR record this Agreement.


