WHEREAS, Lender, is a secured party pursuant to a certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated June 30, 2006, from Sportvision, Inc., a Delaware corporation having an office at 4619 N. Ravenswood, Suite 304, Chicago, Illinois 60640 (“Borrower”) (the “Security Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the parties to said Security Agreement, also entered into a certain Loan and Security Agreement, dated the same day (the “Loan Agreement”);

WHEREAS, said Security Agreement was recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 3342, Frame 0092 with respect to the trademarks and at Reel 17870, Frame 0901 with respect to the patents, both of which are listed on Schedule A attached hereto (the “Collateral”); and

WHEREAS, the Borrower has satisfied its obligations under the Loan Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, Lender hereby terminates and forever releases all liens on and security interests in and to all right, title and interest in the Collateral identified on Schedule A, effective as of the date hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Lender has caused this instrument to be executed by its duly authorized undersigned representative, this 9 day of February, 2016.


