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**RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST
IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY COLLATERAL**

This **RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY COLLATERAL** (this "Release"), dated as of September 16, 2016, is made by **GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY**, as successor in interest by merger to General Electric Capital Corporation, as Administrative Agent (the "Agent"), under the Credit Agreement referred to below (terms used in this Release and not herein defined shall have the meanings set forth in the Credit Agreement).

WHEREAS, in connection with that certain Credit Agreement dated as of September 27, 2013 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), among Laborie Medical Technologies Corp., a Delaware corporation ("US Borrower") and Laborie Medical Technologies Canada ULC, a British Columbia unlimited liability corporation ("Canadian Borrower" and together with US Borrower, the "Borrowers"), Laborie Medical Technologies Corp., as the Borrower Representative, the other Persons party thereto that are designated as a "Credit Party", General Electric Company, as successor in interest by merger to General Electric Capital Corporation, as Administrative Agent for the several financial institutions from time to time party to the Credit Agreement (collectively, the "Lenders"), Healthcare Financial Solutions, LLC, as successor to GE Capital Canada Finance Inc., as Revolver Agent—US and as Revolver Agent—Canada, and together with all general security agreements, trademark security agreements, patent security agreements and copyright security agreements entered into in connection therewith or in connection with prior versions thereof, the Lenders have severally agreed to make extensions of credit to the Borrowers;

WHEREAS, in connection with the Credit Agreement, and pursuant to those certain agreements described on Annex I attached hereto (collectively, the "Security Agreements"), the Borrowers and certain of the other Credit Parties (together with the Borrowers, the "Grantors") granted security interests in the intellectual property owned by Grantors, including those listed on Annex I attached hereto (the "Intellectual Property Collateral"); and

WHEREAS, the Security Agreements were recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and U.S. Copyright Office on the dates and on the reels and frames set forth on Annex I hereto.


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the material covenants and agreements set forth herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Agent hereby **RELEASES**, terminates and discharges, without representation, recourse or warranty whatsoever, all of its rights in, to and under, including its Lien on and security interest in, and right of setoff against, the Intellectual Property Collateral, whether granted pursuant to the Security Agreements or any other agreement or document delivered in connection with the Credit Agreement, and the Agent hereby reassigns any and all such right, title and interest (if any) that the Agent may have in, to and under the Intellectual Property Collateral to Grantors.

The Agent agrees, at Grantors' expense, to cooperate with Grantors and to provide Grantors with the information and additional authorization reasonably required or desirable to effect the release of the Agent's security interest in the released collateral described herein.

This Release and the rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall be governed by, and construed and interpreted in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York.
