FIRST LIEN TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT

This FIRST LIEN TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT (this “**Trademark Security Agreement**”) is made this 28 day of December, 2016, by and among Grantors listed on the signature pages hereof (collectively, jointly and severally, “**Grantors**” and each individually “**Grantor**”), and HEALTHCARE FINANCIAL SOLUTIONS, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, in its capacity as agent for the Secured Parties (in such capacity, together with its successors and permitted assigns in such capacity, “**Administrative Agent**”).

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain First Lien Credit Agreement dated as of December 28, 2016 (as amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented, or otherwise modified from time to time, the “**Credit Agreement**”) by and among KEYSTONE INTERMEDIATE LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, (“**Holdings**”), KEYSTONE PEER REVIEW ORGANIZATION HOLDINGS, INC., a Delaware corporation (“**Borrower**”), the other parties thereto as “**Guarantors**”, the lenders party thereto as “**Lenders**” (such Lenders, together with their respective successors and permitted assigns in such capacity, each, individually, a “**Lender**” and, collectively, the “**Lenders**”), and Administrative Agent, the Secured Parties have agreed to make certain financial accommodations available to Borrower from time to time pursuant to the terms and conditions thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Secured Parties are willing to make the financial accommodations to Borrower as provided for in the Credit Agreement, but only upon the condition, among others, that Grantors shall have executed and delivered to Administrative Agent, for the benefit of Secured Parties, that certain First Lien Security Agreement, dated as of even date herewith (including all annexes, exhibits or schedules thereto, as from time to time amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the “**Security Agreement**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Security Agreement, Grantors are required to execute and deliver to Administrative Agent, for the benefit of Secured Parties, this Trademark Security Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, each Grantor hereby agrees as follows:

1. **DEFINED TERMS.** All initially capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Security Agreement or, if not defined therein, in the Credit Agreement.

2. **GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST IN TRADEMARK COLLATERAL.** Subject to Section 2(a) of the Security Agreement, each Grantor hereby unconditionally grants to Administrative Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties, to

secure the Obligations, a continuing security interest (referred to in this Trademark Security Agreement as the “**Security Interest**”) in all of such Grantor’s right, title and interest in and to the following Collateral, whether now owned or hereafter acquired or arising, but in any event excluding any Excluded Property (collectively, the “**Trademark Collateral**”):

(a) all of its Trademarks and Trademark Licenses to which it is a party including those referred to on Schedule I (which schedule lists as of the date hereof only owned U.S. registered Trademarks, registration applications thereof and Trademark Licenses (other than internet domain names)), provided that Trademark Collateral shall not include any “**intent-to-use**” trademark applications filed with the United States Trademark Office unless and until a statement of use or amendment to allege use is filed with and accepted by the United States Trademark Office in connection with any such “**intent-to-use**” trademark applications;

(b) all goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, each Trademark and each Trademark License; and

(c) all products and all proceeds (as that term is defined in the Code) of the foregoing, including any claim by such Grantor against third parties for past, present or future (i) infringement or dilution of any Trademark or any Trademarks exclusively licensed under any Intellectual Property License, including right to receive any damages, (ii) injury to the goodwill associated with any Trademark, or (iii) right to receive license fees, royalties, and other compensation under any Trademark License.

3. **SECURITY FOR OBLIGATIONS.** This Trademark Security Agreement and the Security Interest created hereby secures the payment and performance of the Secured Obligations, whether now existing or arising hereafter. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, this Trademark Security Agreement secures the payment of all amounts which constitute part of the Secured Obligations and would be owed by Grantors, or any of them, to Administrative Agent, the Secured Parties or any of them, whether or not they are unenforceable or not allowable due to the existence of an insolvency proceeding involving any Grantor.

4. **SECURITY AGREEMENT.** The Security Interest granted pursuant to this Trademark Security Agreement is granted in conjunction with the security interests granted to Administrative Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties, pursuant to the Security Agreement. Each Grantor hereby acknowledges and affirms that the rights and remedies of Administrative Agent with respect to the Security Interest in the Trademark Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Security Agreement, the terms and provisions related to the Administrative Agent’s rights and remedies in respect of the Trademark Collateral of which are incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth herein. To the extent there is any inconsistency between this Trademark Security Agreement and the Security Agreement, the Security Agreement shall control.

5. **AUTHORIZATION TO SUPPLEMENT.** Without limiting Grantors’ obligations under the Security Agreement, Grantors and Administrative Agent may

amend Schedule I to include any future United States registered trademarks or applications therefor of each Grantor. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no failure to so amend Schedule I shall in any way affect, invalidate or detract from Administrative Agent's continuing security interest in all Collateral, whether or not listed on Schedule I.

6. COUNTERPARTS. This Trademark Security Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties on separate counterparts, each of which, when executed and delivered, shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which, when taken together, shall constitute but one and the same Trademark Security Agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of this Trademark Security Agreement by telefacsimile or other electronic method of transmission shall be equally as effective as delivery of an original executed counterpart of this Trademark Security Agreement. Any party delivering an executed counterpart of this Trademark Security Agreement by telefacsimile or other electronic method of transmission (including ".pdf" or ".tif" format) also shall deliver an original executed counterpart of this Trademark Security Agreement but the failure to deliver an original executed counterpart shall not affect the validity, enforceability, and binding effect of this Trademark Security Agreement.


7. TERMINATION. This Trademark Security Agreement shall terminate and the Lien on and security interest in the Trademark Collateral shall be released upon the payment and performance of the Secured Obligations and the termination of all commitments to extend credit in connection therewith, and as otherwise set forth in Section 2(c) of the Security Agreement ("**Termination**"). Upon the termination of this Trademark Security Agreement, the Administrative Agent shall, at the sole cost and expense of the Loan Parties, execute all documents, make all filings, take all other actions reasonably requested by the Grantors to evidence and record the release of the Lien on and security interests in the Trademark Collateral granted herein.

8. The terms of Sections 12.9 ("**Governing Law**") and 12.13 ("**Waiver of Jury Trial**") of the Credit Agreement are incorporated herein by reference, mutatis mutandis, and the parties hereto agree to such terms.


