## **PARTIES**

**DRIZA-BONE PTY LTD** (ACN 000 387 066) of 104 River Hills Road, Eagleby, Queensland  
(**Seller**)

and

**DB TRADEMARKS PTY LTD** (ACN 135 939 669) of the offices of Pitcher Partners, 15  
William Street, Melbourne, Victoria (**Buyer**)

## **RECITALS**

The Seller is the owner of the Trade Marks (as defined below). The Seller has agreed to sell, and the Buyer has agreed to buy, the Trade Marks on the terms set out in this agreement.

## **AGREEMENT**

### **1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

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#### **1.1 Definitions**

In this agreement unless the subject matter or context otherwise requires:

**Completion** means completion of the sale and purchase of the Trade Marks.

**Completion Date** means 19 March 2009.

**Purchase Price** means the sum of \$30,000.00.

**Trade Marks** means the trade marks and trade mark applications set out in annexure 1.

#### **1.2 Interpretation**

In this agreement unless the subject matter or context otherwise requires:

- (a) words denoting any gender include all genders;
- (b) words importing natural persons include corporations, firms, unincorporated associations, partnerships, trusts and any other entities or groups recognised by law;
- (c) reference to any legislation or to any provision of any legislation includes any amendment, modification, consolidation or re-enactment of, or any legislative provision substituted for, and all legislative and statutory instruments issued under, such legislation or such provision;
- (d) the words "written" and "in writing" include any means of visible reproduction of words in a tangible and permanently visible form;
- (e) reference to clauses and annexures are references to clauses and annexures of this agreement;
- (f) reference to any party to this agreement or any other agreement or document includes the party's successors and permitted assigns;

- (g) where a word or phrase is defined, other grammatical forms of that word or phrase have corresponding meanings;
- (h) reference to any document or agreement includes references to such document or agreement as novated, supplemented, varied or replaced from time to time except to the extent excluded by the terms of this agreement or that other document or agreement;
- (i) no rule of construction applies to the disadvantage of a party because that party was responsible for the preparation of this agreement or any part of it;
- (j) the headings to clauses or schedules are for ease of reference only and do not form part of this agreement or affect its interpretation;
- (k) a reference to a time or date in connection with the performance of an obligation by a party is a reference to the time and date in Melbourne, Victoria, Australia even if the obligation is to be performed elsewhere; and
- (l) the warranties contained in clause 4.1 are to be construed separately, and the meaning of each warranty is in no way limited by reference to any other covenant, warranty or representation contained in this document.

## **2. SALE AND PURCHASE**

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### **2.1 Sale of Trade Marks**

The Seller sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to the Buyer, and the Buyer accepts, the Seller's full right, title and interest in, and to, the Trade Marks together with the goodwill associated with its trade in the particular goods and services or class of goods and services upon, or in relation to which, the Trade Marks have been used, for the Purchase Price and with effect from the Completion Date

### **2.2 Purchase Price**

The Buyer will pay the Purchase Price to the Seller on the Completion Date.

### **2.3 Property**

Property to, and risk in, the Trade Marks will pass to the Buyer upon Completion.

### **2.4 Interest**

If the Buyer fails to pay any sum payable by it under this agreement at the time and otherwise in the manner provided herein, the Buyer will pay interest on demand on such sum from the due date of payment until such sum is paid in full at the rate which is the aggregate of 4 per cent per annum and the indicator lending rate from time to time quoted by Australia & New Zealand Banking Group Limited. Interest payable will accrue and be payable from day to day and will be calculated on the basis of actual days elapsed and a 365 day year.

### **3. COMPLETION**

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#### **3.1 Date and Place of Completion**

Completion must take place at the office of Lander & Rogers, Lawyers, Level 12, 600 Bourke Street, Melbourne on the Completion Date or as otherwise agreed between the parties.

#### **3.2 Completion Actions: Seller**

Subject to the Buyer complying with this agreement on the Completion Date, at Completion the Seller must give to the Buyer:

- (a) such instruments of transfer or assignment and other documents executed by the Seller as the Buyer may reasonably require to complete the transfer and assignment of the Trade Marks (and any required registrations, filings or approvals in respect thereof) in accordance with this agreement;
- (b) all documents of title relating to the Trade Marks which are in the possession of the Seller on the Completion Date;
- (c) form 312 executed by Westpac Banking Corporation whereby the Trade Marks are released from debenture charge no 837734; and
- (d) form 312 executed by Lempriere Holdings Pty Ltd whereby the Trade Marks are released from debenture charge no 1590840.

#### **3.3 Completion Actions: Buyer**

Subject to the Seller complying with this agreement on the Completion Date, at Completion the Buyer must pay the Purchase Price to the Seller.

### **4. WARRANTIES & INDEMNITIES**

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#### **4.1 Warranties**

The Buyer acknowledges that notwithstanding anything else in this agreement, the Seller expressly makes no warranties or representations to the Buyer save that:

- (a) the status of registration of the Trade Marks is as set out in schedule1;
- (b) the Seller is the legal and beneficial owner of the Trade Marks;
- (c) the Trade Marks are:
  - (i) fully paid for and have had all fees payable in respect thereof fully paid up to the date of this agreement unless otherwise specified;
  - (ii) in possession of the Seller; and
  - (iii) have been used solely for the purposes of the Seller's business and are solely utilised in its business;

- (d) no security interests or other third party interests or rights exist over any of the Trade Marks other than the debenture charges referred to in clause 3.2(c) and (d) of this agreement;
- (e) to the best of the Seller's knowledge the Trade Marks do not infringe against any industrial or intellectual or other property rights of any other person;
- (f) to the best of the Seller's knowledge, no prosecution, litigation, arbitration proceedings or investigations affecting the Trade Marks:
  - (i) has occurred in the last two years;
  - (ii) is current;
  - (iii) is pending or threatened; or
  - (iv) might arise as a result of current circumstances; and
- (g) to the best of the Seller's knowledge, the Seller is solvent and currently there are no circumstances which could lead to the insolvency of the Seller.

#### **4.2 Indemnities**

The Buyer will indemnify the Seller against any and all claims which may be asserted against or suffered or incurred by the Seller to the extent that such claims arise out of or relate to the ownership or use of the Trade Marks after the Completion Date.

### **5. AUTHORITIES**

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#### **5.1 Authority to Apply for Registration**

The Seller grants to the Buyer the full right and sole power and authority to apply for, and obtain, entry of the Buyer's name as the registered proprietor of the Trade Marks by virtue of this agreement.

#### **5.2 Undertakings**

The Seller undertakes not to do any act which might or would:

- (a) invalidate or put in dispute the Buyer's title to the Trade Marks;
- (b) oppose any application for the registration of the Trade Marks, or invalidate any registration of the Trade Marks in due course;
- (c) support an application to remove the Trade Marks as registered trade marks;
- (d) cause the Registrar of Trade Marks (or similar body in relevant jurisdiction) to require a disclaimer of a monopoly in the Trade Marks or any part of them;
- (e) assist any person directly or indirectly in these acts.

#### **5.3 Authorities**

The Seller agrees to execute all documents to:



- (a) enable the Buyer to apply for and obtain registration as the registered proprietor of the Trade Marks; and
- (b) cancel the registration of any registered user of the trade marks.

## 6. GST

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### 6.1 Definitions

In this section, all terms have the meaning give to them by the:

- *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999*; and
- *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Regulations 1999*;

as amended from time to time and all material published by the Australian Taxation Office.

### 6.2 GST

The parties agree that all amounts payable under this agreement are exclusive of GST.

### 6.3 Tax Invoice

In any Taxable Supply under this agreement the Buyer must, subject to the Seller providing the Buyer with a Tax Invoice, pay to the Seller an additional amount on account of the GST payable in respect of the Taxable Supply within 14 days of receiving that Tax Invoice.

### 6.4 Adjustments

If the amount of GST liability of the Seller under this agreement differs from the amount of GST paid by the Seller, because of the occurrence of an Adjustment Event, then the Seller must issue an Adjustment Note to the Buyer within 7 days of the Adjustment Event. The amount of GST paid by the Buyer will be adjusted accordingly by a further payment by the Buyer to the Seller, or by the Seller to the Buyer, as the case requires, within 7 days of the Seller issuing that Adjustment Note to the Buyer.

### 6.5 Penalties

If any penalty, interest, or additional tax (**Extra Liability**) is imposed in relation to the GST payable under this lease by a party (**Paying Party**) as a result of the other party's default (**Defaulting Party**) under this agreement, the Defaulting Party must pay to the Paying Party the amount of any such Extra Liability within 14 days after the Paying Party provides the Defaulting Party with proof of the Extra Liability. A notice from the Australian Taxation Office will be sufficient proof of the Extra Liability.

## 7. MISCELLANEOUS

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### 7.1 Notices

Any notice given pursuant to this agreement must be in writing and may be given by pre-paid post addressed to the other party at the address specified in this agreement

or as subsequently notified in writing, or by hand delivery or facsimile or email transmission to the same address and any such notice is deemed to have been received:

- (a) if served by post three days after being posted;
- (b) when delivered by hand; or
- (c) if sent by facsimile or email transmission when the transmitting machine produces a written report that the notice has been effectively sent to the other party,

provided that, if the notice is deemed under clause 7.1(a) or (c) to have been received on a day other than a business day, it will be deemed to have been received on the next business day.

**7.2 Waiver**

A waiver by either party of any breach or a failure to enforce or to insist upon the observance of a condition of this agreement will not be a waiver of any other or of any subsequent breach.

**7.3 Severance**

If any part of this agreement is invalid, unenforceable, illegal, void or voidable for any reason, this agreement will be construed and be binding on the parties as if the invalid, unenforceable, illegal, void or voidable part had been deleted from this agreement or read down to the extent necessary to overcome the difficulty.

**7.4 Successors and Assigns**

This agreement will be binding on and continue for the benefit of each party and its successors.

**7.5 Costs**

Whether or not any of the transactions contemplated by this agreement are consummated, each party shall pay its own fees and expenses incidental to the

negotiation, preparation and execution of this agreement, including the fees and disbursements of its lawyers and accountants, except that the Buyer will pay all stamp duty and registration fees on or incidental to the execution of this agreement and the consummation of the transactions hereby contemplated.

**7.6 Assignment**

This agreement is personal to and will not be assigned by either party without the consent in writing of the other.

**7.7 Continuing Obligations**

The expiration or termination of this agreement does not operate to terminate any of the continuing obligations under this agreement and they remain in full force and effect and binding on the party concerned.

**7.8 Further Assurances**

The parties will do everything reasonably necessary to give effect to this agreement and to the transactions contemplated by it and will use all reasonable endeavours to cause relevant third parties to do likewise.

**7.9 Entire Agreement**

This agreement is the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all other communications, negotiations, arrangements and agreements between the parties whether oral or in writing in connection with the subject matter of this agreement.

**7.10 Variation**

No variation of this agreement will be binding on the parties unless in writing and signed by both parties.

**7.11 Applicable Law**

This agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the law of the State of Victoria, Australia.

**7.12 Buyer Capacity**

The Buyer enters into this agreement in its capacity as trustee of the Driza-Bone Trademarks Unit Trust established by deed dated 19 March 2009.



