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TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF PATENT AND TRADEMARK SECURITY INTEREST

This TERMINATION AND RELEASE is made as of September 21, 2017 by SUNTRUST BANK, a Georgia banking corporation, as Agent for the Lenders (“**Secured Party**”) to CEQUINT, INC., a Washington corporation (the “**Grantor**”). All capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Security Agreement and Patent and Trademark Security Agreement referenced below.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Secured Party and Grantor are party to that certain Second Lien Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, dated as of February 15, 2013, by and among Secured Party, in its capacity as Collateral Agent, the Grantor and the other parties party thereto (as the same may be amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the “**Security Agreement**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Grant of Security Interest in Patents and Trademarks, dated as of February 15, 2013 (the “**Patent and Trademark Security Agreement**”), by and between the Grantor and Secured Party, the Grantor granted a security interest to the Secured Party in certain Trademarks, Trademark Licenses, Patents and Patent Licenses (collectively, the “**Patent and Trademark Collateral**”), including the Patent and Trademark Collateral set forth in Exhibit A hereto; and

WHEREAS, Secured Party recorded a Patent and Trademark Security Agreement with the Assignment Division of the United States Patent and Trademark Office on February 15, 2013 at Reel 4964, Frame 0414 with respect to trademarks and on February 18, 2013 at Reel 029824, Frame 0633 with respect to patents; and

WHEREAS, the Secured Party has agreed to release its security interest in the Patent and Trademark Collateral, and to re-convey to Grantor any and all rights held by the Secured Party in and to the Patent and Trademark Collateral.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration for the premises and other good and valuable consideration, including the satisfaction of all obligations, indebtedness and liabilities secured by the Patent and Trademark Collateral pursuant to the Security Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged:

1. Secured Party hereby terminates, releases and discharges its security interest in and to the Patent and Trademark Collateral, and all of the rights, title and interest in and to the Patent and Trademark Collateral originally granted to Secured Party pursuant to the Patent and Trademark Security Agreement shall hereby cease and become void.

2. Secured Party, to the extent granted in the Patent and Trademark Security Agreement, hereby assigns, grants and otherwise re-conveys to Grantor, without any representation, recourse or undertaking by Secured Party, any and all of its right, title and interest in and to the Patent and Trademark Collateral and all goodwill associated therewith originally granted to Secured Party pursuant to the Patent and Trademark Security Agreement.

3. Upon the request of Grantor, Secured Party further agrees to execute all documents necessary to demonstrate and confirm the parties’ intent under this Termination and Release of Patent and Trademark Security Interest.



