AFFIDAVIT TO AFFIRM THE RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

This Affidavit to Affirm the Release of Security Interest is effective as of November 3, 2017.

I, Andrew Church, do hereby declare as follows:

1. I am the Chief Financial Officer and Secretary of Woodstream Corporation, a Pennsylvania corporation, located at 69 North Locust Street, Lititz, Pennsylvania 17543 (the "Company").

2. American Biophysics Corp. ("Grantor") executed that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated as of April 17, 2006 (the "Security Agreement"); all terms used herein without definition have the meanings assigned to them in the Security Agreement.

3. Pursuant to the Security Agreement, Grantor granted to Silicon Valley Bank (the "Lender") a security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under its registered and unregistered intellectual property collateral (all of which shall collectively be called the "Intellectual Property Collateral"), including, without limitation, the following:

(a) any and all copyright rights, copyright applications, copyright registrations and like protections in each work or authorship and derivative work thereof, whether published or unpublished, registered or unregistered, and whether or not the same also constitutes a trade secret, then or thereafter existing, created, acquired or held, including without limitation those set forth on Exhibit A attached to the Security Agreement (collectively, the "Copyrights");

(b) any and all trade secret rights, including any rights to unpatented inventions, know-how, operating manuals, license rights and agreements, and confidential information, and any and all intellectual property rights in computer software and computer software products then or thereafter existing, created, acquired or held;

(c) any and all design rights which may be available to Grantor then or thereafter existing, created, acquired or held;

(d) all patents, patent applications and like protections including, without limitation, improvements, divisions, continuations, renewals, reissues, extensions, and continuations-in-part of the same, including without limitation the patents and patent applications set forth on Exhibit B attached to the Security Agreement and on Schedule A attached hereto (collectively, the "Patents");

(e) any trademark and service mark rights, slogans, trade dress, and tradenames, trade styles, whether registered or not, applications to register and registrations of the same and like protections, and the entire goodwill of the business of Grantor connected with and symbolized by such trademarks, including without limitation those set forth on Exhibit C attached to the Security Agreement and on Schedule A attached hereto (collectively, the "Trademarks");

(f) all mask works or similar rights available for the protection of semiconductor chips, then owned or thereafter acquired, including, without limitation those set forth on Exhibit D attached to the Security Agreement (collectively, the "Mask Works");

(g) any and all claims for damages by way of past, present and future infringements of any of the rights included above, with the right, but not the obligation, to sue for and collect such damages for said use or infringement of the intellectual property rights identified above;

(h) all licenses or other rights to use any of the Copyrights, Patents, Trademarks, or Mask Works and all license fees and royalties arising from such use to the extent permitted by such license or rights, including, without limitation those set forth on Exhibit E attached to the Security Agreement; and

(i) all amendments, extensions, renewals and extensions of any of the Copyrights, Trademarks, Patents, or Mask Works; and

(j) all proceeds and products of the foregoing, including without limitation all payments under insurance or any indemnity or warranty payable in respect of any of the foregoing

(the foregoing security interest being the "Security Interest").

4. The Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO") on May 5, 2006 at Reel 3303, Frame 0589 with respect to the Trademarks and at Reel 017575, Frame 0435 with respect to the Patents.

5. During November 2006, Grantor was placed in receivership by court order.

6. On April 20, 2007, the Company acquired all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks and Patents set forth on Schedule A attached hereto and other Intellectual Property Collateral pursuant to that certain Assignment of Trademarks recorded with the USPTO on April 23, 2007 at Reel 3527, Frame 0355 and that certain Assignment of Patents and Patent Applications recorded with the USPTO on April 23, 2007 at Reel 019193, Frame 0041.

7. Based on information and belief, the Security Interest was released in connection with the receivership proceedings.

8. Due to unknown reasons, documentation evidencing the termination and release of the Security Interest was not filed with the USPTO.

9. Because the Security Interest has been terminated, released and discharged, the Security Interest no longer exists in favor of the Lender.

The undersigned, being hereby advised that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. 1001, declares that the facts set

forth in this Affidavit are true; all statements made of his/her own knowledge are true; and all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true.

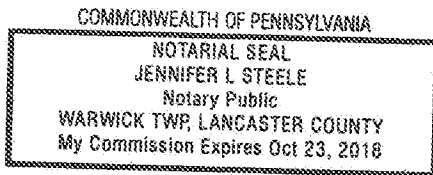
