TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

THIS Agreement is between The Center for Advanced Biotechnology and Medicine ("Assignor"), an entity composed of Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey, and the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey, both public educational institutions of higher education of New Jersey, 679 Hoes Lane, Piscataway, New Jersey; and Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey ("Assignee"), an instrumentality of the State of New Jersey, 335 George Street, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08901.

WHEREAS, Assignor owns the trademarks identified in Schedule A, including but not limited to common-law trademarks and registrations, and the goodwill associated with all the foregoing (collectively the "Marks"); and

WHEREAS, Assignee wants to acquire all global rights and licenses, if any, to the Marks; and Assignor wants to transfer all global rights and licenses to the Marks, if any, to Assignee.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and exchange of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:


1. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee all its right, title and interest in and to the Marks globally, including all the goodwill associated with such Marks. This assignment includes but is not limited to assignment of the common-law marks and registrations in the attached Schedule A. It is the intention of the Parties that all right, title and interest acquired by Assignee shall include all rights enjoyed by Assignor prior to the assignment herein.

2. This Agreement includes the assignment to Assignee of the rights to sue, recover and obtain damages for any illegal activity perpetrated upon the Marks, the goodwill of the Marks, or recoverable by Assignor in association with such illegal activity, notwithstanding the date such activity may have occurred, the foregoing to the fullest extent as would have been held by Assignor if no assignment were made.

3. Assignor agrees to cooperate as reasonably necessary with Assignee in executing documents necessary to perfect this assignment and assure its recordation with any governmental authority.
