Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10.154 of the Texas Business Organizations Code (the "TBOC"), the undersigned Texas corporation, Jim F. Webb, Inc. (the "Converting Entity"), adopts the following Certificate of Conversion for the purpose of converting into JW Powerline, LLC, a Texas limited liability company (the "Converted Entity"), and hereby certifies as follows:

1. The name of the Converting Entity is Jim F. Webb, Inc. The Converting Entity is a corporation. The jurisdiction of formation of the Converting Entity is Texas. The Converting Entity was originally formed pursuant to the Articles of Incorporation filed on April 16, 1984 and assigned the filing number 70066600.

2. The Converting Entity plans to convert into the Converted Entity. The Converted Entity will be named JW Powerline, LLC and will be a limited liability company formed under the laws of the State of Texas. A Plan of Conversion (the "Plan") has been approved by the Converting Entity.

3. An executed Plan is on file at the principal place of business of the Converting Entity. The address of the principal place of business of the Converting Entity is 700 S. Fairgrounds Road, Midland, Texas 79701. An executed Plan will be on file, from and after the conversion, at the principal place of business of the Converted Entity. The address of the principal place of business of the Converted Entity will be 700 S. Fairgrounds Road, Midland, Texas 79701.

4. A copy of the Plan will be furnished by the Converting Entity (prior to the conversion) or by the Converted Entity (after the conversion), on written request and without cost, to any owner or member of the Converting Entity or the Converted Entity.

5. The Converted Entity is a Texas limited liability company. The Certificate of Formation of the Converted Entity is attached to this Certificate as Exhibit A hereto.

6. The Plan has been approved as required by the laws of the jurisdiction of formation and the governing documents of the Converting Entity.

7. The Converted Entity acknowledges that it will be responsible for all Texas franchise tax obligations of the Converting Entity.

The undersigned, in accordance with the Texas Business Organizations Code (the "TBOC"), does hereby adopt the following Certificate of Formation of JW Powerline, LLC, a Texas limited liability company (the "Company"). The Company is being formed pursuant to the Plan of Conversion of Jim F. Webb, Inc., a Texas corporation with a principal place of business at 700 S. Fairgrounds Road, Midland, Texas 79701 originally formed pursuant to the Articles of Incorporation filed on April 16, 1984, and assigned the filing number 700666600.

ARTICLE ONE

The filing entity being formed is a limited liability company. The name of the Company is JW Powerline, LLC.

ARTICLE TWO

The Company is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the TBOC.

ARTICLE THREE

The address of the initial registered office of the Company is 1701 Directors Blvd., Suite 300, Austin, Texas 78744, and the name of the initial registered agent of the Company at that address is Registered Agent Solutions, Inc.

ARTICLE FOUR

The Company is to be managed by its members, and will not have "managers" as defined in the TBOC. The name and address of the Company's initial sole member are as follows: JW Powerline Holdings, Inc., 700 S. Fairgrounds Road, Midland, Texas 79701.

ARTICLE FIVE

A member of the Company shall not be liable to the Company or its members for monetary damages for an act or omission in the member's capacity as a managing member, except that this Article does not eliminate or limit the liability of a member to the extent the member is found liable for (i) a breach of the member's duty of loyalty, if any, to the Company or its members; (ii) an act or omission not in good faith that constitutes a breach of duty of the member to the Company or an act or omission that involves intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law; (iii) a transaction from which the member received an improper benefit, whether or not the benefit resulted from an action taken within the scope of the member's duties as a managing member of the Company; or (iv) an act or omission for which the liability of a member is expressly provided in an applicable statute. Any repeal or amendment of this Article by the members of the Company shall be prospective only and shall not adversely affect any limitation on the liability of a member of the Company existing at the time of such repeal or

amendment. In addition to the circumstances in which a member of the Company is not liable as set forth in the preceding sentences, a member shall not be liable to the fullest extent permitted by any provision of the statutes of Texas hereafter enacted that further limits the liability of a member.
