

#### RELEASE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY INTEREST

This Release of Intellectual Property Security Interest, dated as of November 9, 2018 (this "Release"), is made by THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTIA, as collateral agent under the Terminated Credit Agreement (as defined below) (in such capacity, the "Collateral Agent"), in favor of Colfax Fluid Handling Reliability Services Company, a Delaware corporation (formerly known as Lubrication Systems Company of Texas LLC, which merged with Total Lubrication Management Company, with Total Lubrication Management Company being the surviving entity, which surviving entity subsequently changed its name to Colfax Fluid Handling Reliability Services Company) (the "Grantor").

WHEREAS, the Grantor and the Collateral Agent were parties to (i) a certain Credit Agreement dated as of May 30, 2003 (as amended, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Terminated Credit Agreement") by and among Colfax Corporation, a Delaware corporation, the other borrowers party thereto, the other guarantors party thereto (such borrowers and guarantors collectively, the "Loan Parties"), the Collateral Agent, The Bank of Nova Scotia, as administrative agent (the "Administrative Agent") and the other financial institutions and lender parties party thereto, and (ii) a certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement Supplement dated as of January 31, 2007 (the "Intellectual Property Security Agreement") pursuant to which Grantor granted to the Collateral Agent a security interest over all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to certain intellectual property, including those set forth in Schedule A hereto (the "IP Collateral"), and was recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 018847, Frame 0151 on February 2, 2007 with respect to certain patents and at Reel 003474, Frame 0575 on February 2, 2007 with respect to certain trademarks.

WHEREAS, the Grantor and the Collateral Agent are parties to that certain Payoff Letter dated as of May 13, 2008 (the "Payoff Letter"), by and between the Collateral Agent, the Administrative Agent and the Loan Parties, pursuant to which the Terminated Credit Agreement and all other Credit Documents (as defined in the Payoff Letter) were terminated and all security interests and other liens granted to or held by the Collateral Agent in the assets and property of the Loan Parties, including the IP Collateral, to secure the obligations of the Loan Parties under or relating to the Terminated Credit Agreement and the other Credit Documents (as defined in the Payoff Letter) were terminated (collectively, the "Termination").

WHEREAS, the Grantor and the Collateral Agent wish to record in the United States Patent and Trademark Office this Release as a notice of the Termination;

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration recited in the Payoff Letter and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Collateral Agent hereby gives notice of the Termination, including the release of any and all security interests and other liens granted to or held by the Collateral Agent in the IP Collateral pursuant to the Intellectual Property Security Agreement, and of the reconveyance to the extent of its interest therein to the Grantor.
