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**RELEASE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY INTERESTS**

This Release of Intellectual Property Security Interests (“Release”) is granted and conveyed as of April 4, 2019 by Bank of America, N.A., a national banking association, located at 333 S. Hope Street, Ste. 1300, Los Angeles, CA 90071, in its capacity as collateral agent pursuant to the Credit Agreement (in such capacity, the “Collateral Agent”), in favor of Associated Air Center, L.P., a Texas limited partnership, located at 6710 N. Scottsdale Road, Suite 250, Scottsdale, AZ 85253 (“Associated Air”), StandardAero Business Aviation Services, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, located at 6710 N. Scottsdale Road, Suite 250, Scottsdale, AZ 85253 (“StandardAero”), StandardAero Component Services, Inc. (formerly TSS Aviation, Inc.), an Ohio corporation, located at 6710 N. Scottsdale Road, Suite 250, Scottsdale, AZ 85253 (“StandardAero Component”), Standard Aero (San Antonio) Inc., a Delaware corporation, located at 6710 N. Scottsdale Road, Suite 250, Scottsdale, AZ 85253 (“StandardAero San Antonio”), PAS Technologies Inc., a Delaware corporation, located at 6710 N. Scottsdale Road, Suite 250, Scottsdale, AZ 85253 (“PAS Technologies” and together with Associated Air, StandardAero, StandardAero Component and StandardAero San Antonio, each, a “Pledgor” and collectively, the “Pledgors”). Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Security Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent and the Pledgors are party to that certain Security Agreement, dated as of July 7, 2015 (as amended, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Security Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent, Associated Air, StandardAero and StandardAero Component are parties to a Trademark Security Agreement dated as of July 7, 2015 (the “SA Trademark Security Agreement”), notice of which was recorded on July 7, 2015 at the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the “PTO”) at Reel/Frame 5569/0919;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the SA Trademark Security Agreement, Associated Air, StandardAero and StandardAero Component pledged and granted to the Collateral Agent for the ratable benefit of the Secured Parties, a lien on and security interest in, all of the right, title and interest of Associated Air, StandardAero and StandardAero Component in, to and under the Trademarks included in the Pledged Collateral, together with all associated Goodwill, including those trademarks of Associated Air, StandardAero and StandardAero Component listed on Schedule A attached hereto, wherever located, and whether then existing or thereafter arising or acquired from time to time (other than Excluded Assets, including any Trademark application filed in the PTO pursuant to Section 1(b) of the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. § 1051, et seq.) unless and until evidence of use of the mark in interstate commerce is submitted to the PTO pursuant to Section 1(c) or 1(d) of the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. § 1051, et seq.);

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent and PAS Technologies are parties to a Trademark Security Agreement dated as of July 25, 2017 (the “PAS Trademark Security Agreement”), notice of which was recorded on July 26, 2017 at the PTO at Reel/Frame 6114/0675;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the PAS Trademark Security Agreement, PAS Technologies pledged and granted to the Collateral Agent for the ratable benefit of the Secured Parties, a lien on and security interest in, all of the right, title and interest of PAS Technologies in, to and under the Trademarks included in the Pledged Collateral, together with all associated Goodwill, including those trademarks of PAS Technologies listed on Schedule A attached hereto, wherever located, and whether then existing or thereafter arising or acquired from time to time (other than Excluded Assets, including any Trademark application filed in the PTO pursuant to Section 1(b) of the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. § 1051, et seq.) unless

and until evidence of use of the mark in interstate commerce is submitted to the PTO pursuant to Section 1(c) or 1(d) of the Lanham Act (15 U.S.C. § 1051, et seq.);

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent and StandardAero San Antonio are parties to a Patent Security Agreement dated as of July 7, 2015 (the “SA Patent Security Agreement”), notice of which was recorded on July 7, 2015 at the PTO at Reel/Frame 036092/0037;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the SA Patent Security Agreement, StandardAero San Antonio pledged and granted to the Collateral Agent for the ratable benefit of the Secured Parties, a lien on and security interest in, all of the right, title and interest of StandardAero San Antonio in, to and under the Patents included in the Pledged Collateral, including those patents of StandardAero San Antonio listed on Schedule B attached hereto, wherever located, and whether then existing or thereafter arising or acquired from time to time (other than Excluded Assets);

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent and PAS Technologies are parties to a Patent Security Agreement dated as of July 25, 2017 (the “PAS Patent Security Agreement”), notice of which was recorded on July 26, 2017 at the PTO at Reel/Frame 43339/0039;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the PAS Patent Security Agreement, PAS Technologies pledged and granted to the Collateral Agent for the ratable benefit of the Secured Parties, a lien on and security interest in, all of the right, title and interest of PAS Technologies in, to and under the Patents included in the Pledged Collateral, including those patents of StandardAero San Antonio listed on Schedule B attached hereto, wherever located, and whether then existing or thereafter arising or acquired from time to time (other than Excluded Assets); and

WHEREAS, each Pledgor has requested that Collateral Agent terminate, release and reassign its Security Interests in all right, title and interest of Collateral Agent in, to and under all of the: (i) Trademarks included in the Pledged Collateral, including the trademarks listed in Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof, and (ii) Patents included in the Pledged Collateral, including the patents listed in Schedule B attached hereto and made a part hereof, in each case, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which the parties acknowledge, each Pledgor and Collateral Agent hereby agree as follows:

1. All of Collateral Agent’s security interests, grants, liens, pledges, mortgages, and other encumbrances of any kind whatsoever created against the Trademarks and Patents pursuant to the SA Trademark Security Agreement, the PAS Trademark Security Agreement, the PAS Patent Security Agreement or SA Patent Security Agreement, as applicable (collectively, the “Security Interests”) are hereby automatically terminated, released and discharged, and the Collateral Agent shall sign any further documents reasonably requested by each Pledgor and do such other acts that each Pledgor (or its respective agents or designees) reasonably request, at such Pledgor’s cost and expense, including filings with the PTO against the Trademarks and Patents, in order to effect the termination, release and discharge of all of the Security Interests, each at such Pledgor’s cost and expense. The Collateral Agent hereby authorizes each Pledgor, or each Pledgor’s authorized representative, to record this Release with the PTO.
2. If and to the extent that Collateral Agent has acquired any right, title or interest in or to any of the Trademarks and Patents, it hereby assigns and transfers such rights, title or interest to the applicable Pledgor, along with any goodwill in the Trademarks and Patents that the Collateral Agent may have acquired.


3. This Release shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns. This Release and any amendments, waivers, consents or supplements hereto may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties hereto in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed to be an original, but all such counterparts together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery of any executed counterpart of a signature page to this Release by facsimile or other electronic transmission shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart of this Release. Sections 10.09 and 10.10 of the Credit Agreement are incorporated herein, mutatis mutandis, as if a part hereof.
