Pursuant to Title 8, Section 252 of the General Corporation Law of the State of Delaware, the undersigned corporation executed the following Certificate of Merger:

FIRST: The name of the surviving corporation is Clondalkin Pharma & Healthcare Inc., a Delaware corporation, and the name of the corporation being merged into this surviving corporation is Westlake Industries, Inc., an Illinois corporation.
