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TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT, LICENSE, AND CO-EXISTENCE AGREEMENT

THIS TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT, LICENSE, AND CO-EXISTENCE AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is made as of July 1, 2019, by and between Safari Club International Foundation, a Nevada non-profit corporation with an address of 4800 West Gates Pass Road, Tucson, Arizona 85745 ("Foundation"), and Safari Club International, an Arizona non-profit corporation with an address of 501 2nd St NE, Washington, D.C. 20002 ("International") (individually, each the "Party," and together, the "Parties").

WHEREAS, Foundation and International were previously part of the same entity and have each subsequently pursued different non-profit business activities within the field of hunting and conservation;

WHEREAS, Foundation provides educational, charitable, and philanthropic services and related products in pursuit of its mission ("Foundation's Products and Services") and has used the trademarks listed in Schedules A and B in connection with Foundation's Products and Services;

WHEREAS, International provides, among other things, lobbying services in support of hunting and conservation, and related products, in pursuit of its mission ("International's Products and Services") and has used the trademarks listed in Schedule A, pursuant to the Parties' 2000 License Agreement (the "2000 License Agreement"), in connection with International's Products and Services;

WHEREAS, Foundation is the owner of all right, title, and interest in and to the trademarks and registrations listed in Schedule A attached hereto, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by those trademarks;

WHEREAS, Foundation is also the owner of all right, title, and interest in and to several trademarks and registrations incorporating the term SAFARI CLUB INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION and SCI FOUNDATION (the "SCIF Marks"), as shown in Schedule B, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by those trademarks;

WHEREAS, Foundation is also the owner of all right, title, and interest in and to the trademarks and registrations listed in Schedule C (the "SABLES Marks"), together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by those trademarks;

WHEREAS, Foundation is also the owner of all right, title, and interest in the <safariclub.org> domain name and, until July 1, 2019, was the listed registrant of the <safariclub.org> domain name with GoDaddy.com, LLC;

WHEREAS, International desires to acquire all right, title and interest in and to the trademarks and registrations listed in Schedule A attached hereto, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by those trademarks;

WHEREAS, International desires to acquire all right, title, and interest in the <safariclub.org> domain name and the registration thereof;

WHEREAS, International is also the owner of all right, title, and interest in the <safariclubfoundation.org> domain name and, until July 1, 2019, was the listed registrant of the <safariclubfoundation.org> domain name with GoDaddy.com, LLC; and

WHEREAS, Foundation desires to acquire all right, title, and interest in the <safariclubfoundation.org> domain name and the registration thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Parties intend that this Agreement be made of record in relevant Trademark Offices worldwide.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of good and valuable consideration as set forth herein, the sufficiency and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

ASSIGNMENT TO INTERNATIONAL

1. Foundation hereby irrevocably sells, assigns, grants, transfers and sets over unto International and International's successors and assigns, all of Foundation's right, title and interest throughout the world in and to the trademarks and associated registrations listed in the attached Schedule A,¹ including all stylizations and logos associated therewith, together with all national, foreign, state and common law rights, registrations or applications, renewals or extensions thereof or applications for such; all goodwill associated therewith, all benefits, privileges, causes of action and remedies relating to any of the foregoing, whether before or hereafter accrued including, without limitation, the exclusive rights to apply for and maintain all such registrations, renewals and/or extensions; to sue for all past, present or future infringements or other violations of any rights in the intellectual property; and to settle and retain proceeds from any such actions.

PARTIES' ACKNOWLEDGMENT, CO-EXISTENCE, AND COOPERATION

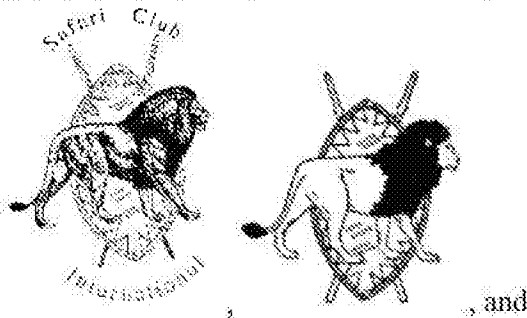
2. Schedule B sets forth the marks and registrations currently owned by Foundation that (a) are comprised of the words SAFARI CLUB INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION or (b) SCI FOUNDATION, and that are not assigned to International under this Agreement. The Parties acknowledge that Foundation may continue to use and maintain such marks and registrations in its own name.

¹ The Parties are in the process of recording an entity name change for three registrations in Schedule A – Mexico Registration Nos. 654358 and 1200556 and South Africa Registration No. 1999/15480. These registrations are held in the name of "Safari Club International" as of July 1, 2019, as a name change to "Safari Club International Foundation" was not recorded in the appropriate Trademark Offices at the time the entity changed its name in or about 1999. The Parties agree to cooperate fully and provide all necessary documentation to effect the name changes.

3. Foundation agrees to use the term SAFARI CLUB INTERNATIONAL only as part of the composite mark SAFARI CLUB INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION and only in association with Foundation's Products and Services.
4. International agrees to use SAFARI CLUB INTERNATIONAL only in association with International's Products and Services, and further agrees not to use SAFARI CLUB INTERNATIONAL in conjunction with the term FOUNDATION.
5. The Parties are not aware of any instances of actual confusion arising from past use of the marks listed in Schedules A and B.
6. The Parties believe and agree that use of the marks set forth in Schedules A and B, as set forth in this Agreement, will not result in a likelihood of confusion in view of the differences between the Parties' respective products and services, their channels of trade in the fields in which they operate, and the sophistication of their consumers.
7. Should any instances of confusion arising from concurrent use of the marks listed in Schedules A and B come to the attention of either Party, the Parties shall cooperate to resolve and avoid similar confusion in the future.
8. The Parties agree to execute such written instruments, extend such other cooperation and perform such other acts as may be reasonably necessary or advisable to effectuate the rights set forth in this Agreement, all at the sole cost and expense of the requesting Party, including but not limited to, making all required filings with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and foreign equivalents; and the non-requesting Party hereby irrevocably appoints the requesting Party and any of its officers as the non-requesting Party's attorney in fact to undertake such acts in the non-requesting Party's name.

LICENSE TO FOUNDATION

9. Concurrent with and subject to the terms of Paragraphs 1 through 8 of this Agreement, International grants to Foundation a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free, sublicenseable



license to use the marks



(the "Lion & Shield Marks") in association with Foundation's Products and Services, including as a component of Foundation's corporate name and as a component of names, logos and stylized marks used in association with Foundation's business activities, along with the rights afforded under registrations corresponding to the

logos shown above, as listed in Schedule A (the "International License of Lion & Shield Marks").

10. Foundation shall have the right to grant sublicenses to all or any portion of its rights under the International License of Lion & Shield Marks, provided that each such sublicense shall be subject to, and consistent with, the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the grant of any such sublicenses shall not relieve Foundation of any of its obligations under this Agreement. Foundation will notify International in advance and in writing of the grant of any sublicenses. Use by Foundation and any of its sublicensees of the Lion & Shield Marks under the International License of Lion & Shield Marks shall inure to the benefit of International.
11. Foundation agrees that its use of the Lion & Shield Marks as described in Paragraph 9 will be continuous and in conformity with all relevant statutes, regulations, and ordinances. Foundation further agrees that its use may be subject to such other reasonable conditions as International may from time to time establish for other of its licensees of the Lion & Shield Marks.
12. At the request of International, Foundation will, during the term of this International License of Lion & Shield Marks but not more than once each year, forward to International representative materials showing use of the Lion & Shield Marks as described in Paragraph 9. Foundation will also forward to International from time to time and on reasonable notice such other materials and information as may be required by International to maintain any trademark registrations for the Lion & Shield Marks.
13. The Parties agree that they will not use the Lion & Shield Marks, as described in Paragraph 9, on or in connection with materials that promote unlawful activity or that otherwise bring the Lion & Shield Marks into disrepute.
14. In the event that Foundation ceases use of the Lion & Shield Marks, as described in Paragraph 9, for three (3) consecutive years, the International License of Lion & Shield Marks shall terminate and Foundation shall have no further right to use the Lion & Shield Marks as a mark or name or a component of a mark or name.
15. Foundation will not, without International's prior written consent, file any applications to register the Lion & Shield Marks or any mark or name including the Lion & Shield Marks, and will not expand its use of the Lion & Shield Marks beyond that described in Paragraph 9.
16. Foundation will not undertake any legal action to enforce any rights in the Lion & Shield Marks without International's prior written consent, which shall not be unreasonably withheld. Foundation will bring to International's attention any infringement of the Lion & Shield Marks by any third party. Foundation may request that International take appropriate action to protect the Lion & Shield Marks, but International is not obligated by this Agreement to take any action other than to maintain its trademark registrations by filing such renewal applications and declarations of use as may be required to prevent expiration or cancellation of the registrations, on the request of Foundation and on reasonable notice.

17. The Parties agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless each other from and against any and all claims, demands, liabilities, expenses, damages and costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) arising out of or relating to the other Party's use of the Lion & Shield Marks as described in Paragraph 9. Should any claim covered by the foregoing indemnity be asserted against a Party, that Party shall notify the other Party promptly and give it an opportunity to defend the same, and the notifying Party shall extend reasonable cooperation to the other Party in connection with such defense. In the event the other Party fails to defend the same within a reasonable time, the notifying Party shall be entitled to assume the defense thereof, and the other Party shall repay the notifying Party for all of the notifying Party's expenses reasonably incurred in connection with the defense (including reasonable attorneys' fees, expenses and settlement payments).

LICENSE TO INTERNATIONAL

18. Concurrent with and subject to the terms of Paragraphs 1 through 17 of this Agreement, Foundation grants to International a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free, sublicenseable license to use the marks listed in Schedule C (the "SABLES Marks") in association with the following services:

- **SABLES**: promoting the interests of the members of the association and public awareness concerning issues of wildlife, conservation and hunting
- **SCIF SABLES FIRST FOR EDUCATION (Logo)**: (a) promoting the interests of the members of the wildlife conservation, hunting, and outdoor education association and promoting public awareness concerning issues of wildlife, conservation, and hunting; and (b) Charitable fundraising services; Providing educational scholarships; Providing grants for wildlife conservation and hunting and shooting sports education programs

(the "Foundation License of SABLES Marks").

19. International shall have the right to grant sublicenses to all or any portion of its rights under the Foundation License of the SABLES Marks, provided that each such sublicense shall be subject to, and consistent with, the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the grant of any such sublicenses shall not relieve International of any of its obligations under this Agreement. International will notify Foundation in advance and in writing of the grant of any sublicenses. Use by International and any of its sublicensees under the Foundation License of SABLES Marks shall inure to the benefit of Foundation.
20. International agrees that its use of the SABLES Marks as described in Paragraph 18 will be continuous and in conformity with all relevant statutes, regulations, and ordinances. International further agrees that its use may be subject to such other reasonable conditions as Foundation may from time to time establish for other of its licensees of the SABLES Marks.

21. At the request of Foundation, International will, during the term of the Foundation License of SABLES Marks, but not more than once each year, forward to Foundation representative materials showing use of the SABLES Marks as described in Paragraph 18. International will also forward to Foundation from time to time and on reasonable notice such other materials and information as may be required by Foundation to maintain any trademark registrations for the SABLES Marks.
22. The Parties agree that they will not use the SABLES Marks, as described in Paragraph 18, on or in connection with materials that promote unlawful activity or that otherwise bring the SABLES marks into disrepute.
23. In the event that International ceases use of the SABLES Marks, as described in Paragraph 18, for three (3) consecutive years, the Foundation License of SABLES Marks shall terminate and International shall have no further right to use the SABLES Marks.
24. International will not, without Foundation's prior written consent, file any applications to register the SABLES Marks or any mark or name including the SABLES Marks, and will not expand its use of the SABLES Marks beyond that described in Paragraph 18.
25. International will not undertake any legal action to enforce any rights in the SABLES Marks without Foundation's prior written consent, which shall not be unreasonably withheld. International will bring to Foundation's attention any infringement of the SABLES Marks by any third party. International may request that Foundation take appropriate action to protect the SABLES Marks, but Foundation is not obligated by this Agreement to take any action other than to maintain its trademark registrations by filing such renewal applications and declarations of use as may be required to prevent expiration or cancellation of the registrations for the SABLES Marks, on the request of International and on reasonable notice.
26. The Parties agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless each other from and against any and all claims, demands, liabilities, expenses, damages and costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) arising out of or relating to the other Party's use of the SABLES Marks as described in Paragraph 18. Should any claim covered by the foregoing indemnity be asserted against a Party, that Party shall notify the other Party promptly and give it an opportunity to defend the same, and the notifying Party shall extend reasonable cooperation to the other Party in connection with such defense. In the event the other Party fails to defend the same within a reasonable time, the notifying Party shall be entitled to assume the defense thereof, and the other Party shall repay the notifying Party for all of the notifying Party's expenses reasonably incurred in connection with the defense (including reasonable attorneys' fees, expenses and settlement payments).
27. As consideration for the Foundation License of SABLES Marks, all funds raised through International's fundraising activities under the SABLES Marks will be used to benefit the Safari Club International Foundation Education Committee.

DOMAIN NAME TRANSFER TO INTERNATIONAL

28. On July 1, 2019, Foundation submitted to ICANN a request to change the name of the <safariclub.org> registrant from Foundation to International and this change was effected in WHOIS records.
29. For good and valuable consideration, including but not limited to International maintaining on its homepage at <safariclub.org> a link to Foundation's homepage at <safariclubfoundation.org>, Foundation hereby irrevocably sells, assigns, transfers, and conveys to International all right, title, and interest in and to the <safariclub.org> domain name, including the current registration thereof with GoDaddy.com, LLC.

DOMAIN NAME TRANSFER TO FOUNDATION

30. On July 1, 2019, International submitted to ICANN a request to change the name of the <safariclubfoundation.org> registrant from International to Foundation and this change was effected in WHOIS records.
31. For good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, International hereby irrevocably sells, assigns, transfers, and conveys to Foundation all right, title, and interest in and to the <safariclubfoundation.org> domain name, including the current registration thereof with GoDaddy.com, LLC.

PAYMENTS TO FOUNDATION AND INTERNATIONAL

32. On July 1, 2019, International paid to Foundation \$731,800.00 as payment for the assignments and other rights set forth herein. International effectuated the Payment by wire transfer to Foundation's account number 4000701243.
33. On January 1, 2019, International paid to Foundation \$100,000 as the 2019 payment under the 2000 License Agreement (the "Payment"). On July 1, 2019 Foundation refunded to International \$50,000 as the pro-rated amount for July 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 under the 2000 License Agreement.
34. The Parties note that consideration for Norway Registration No. 300613 and European Union Registration No. 017759663 (both shown in Schedule A) has separately been provided by International to Foundation.

MISCELLANEOUS

35. This Agreement shall be worldwide in scope.
36. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Arizona, without regard to its rules or principles concerning choice of laws. The Parties agree that any dispute arising from or related to this Agreement shall be brought exclusively in the state courts of the State of Arizona or in the United States District Court for the District of Arizona. The Parties consent to such venues as the exclusive venues for such disputes and expressly waive any defense of personal jurisdiction in the state courts of the State of Arizona and/or the United States District Court for the District of Arizona.

37. The Parties shall notify each other promptly of any action believed to be in conflict with this Agreement, whereupon receiving such notice the offending Party shall investigate immediately and take such steps as may be necessary to comply with this Agreement.
38. Any notices or communications required or permitted to be given by this Agreement must be (i) given in writing and (ii) personally delivered or mailed, by prepaid, certified mail or overnight courier, or transmitted by facsimile or electronic mail transmission (including PDF), to the Party to whom such notice or communication is directed, to the mailing address or regularly-monitored electronic mail address of such party as follows:

Any such notice or communication shall be deemed to have been given on (i) the day such notice or communication is personally delivered, (ii) three (3) days after such notice or communication is mailed by prepaid certified or registered mail, (iii) one (1) working day after such notice or communication is sent by overnight courier, or (iv) the day such notice or communication is faxed or sent electronically. A Party may, for purposes of this Agreement, change its address, fax number, email address or the person to whom a

notice or other communication is marked to the attention of, by giving notice of such change to the other Party pursuant to this Paragraph 38.

39. This Agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
40. This Agreement shall be deemed to have been jointly drafted by the Parties and shall be construed in accordance with its fair meaning, and not strictly construed against either Party.
41. The Schedules referenced herein and attached hereto are hereby incorporated into this Agreement and may be revised from time to time upon consent of Foundation, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
42. This Agreement may be signed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and together which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
43. All notices, demands, or other communications given under this Agreement shall be sent in writing to the other party.
