NONPROFIT CORPORATION
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation pursuant to the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Convention Liaison Council.

SECOND: The period of duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the promotion of a strong convention, meeting, trade show, exhibit and travel industry through providing an open forum for information exchange and addressing industry issues; through conducting educational activities for participants in all sectors of industry; through developing policies, guidelines and services for the industry; through acquainting the general public with the contributions made to the economy and public welfare by the industry; and through providing other activities that promote the convention, meeting, trade show and exhibit industry and travel.

In furtherance of these purposes, the organization may carry out whatever programs are necessary, including but not limited to, publishing materials, conducting courses, meetings, and

seminars, compiling and providing data, producing films, and using new technology and techniques to communicate within the industry and with the public.

FOURTH: The corporation shall consist of a single class of members.

FIFTH: The designation of this class of members, the qualifications and rights of the members of this class, and conferring, limiting or denying the right to vote shall be as provided in the bylaws.

SIXTH: The directors shall be elected or appointed as shall be provided in the bylaws.

SEVENTH: No assets or income of the Corporation shall be distributed to or inure to the benefit of any individual members, directors or officers of the Corporation upon dissolution or final liquidation.

EIGHTH: The address, including street and number, of its initial registered office is 1055 Thomas Jefferson Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20007, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Kathleen McDermott.
