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2. ASSIGNEE hereby assumes and agrees to be bound by all of ASSIGNOR's obligations under the TRADEMARKS. ASSIGNEE hereby agrees to hold ASSIGNOR harmless for any and all liabilities as a result of the TRADEMARKS and the obligations thereof.

3. This Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns.


