RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST BY DECLARATION

I, Peter Talosig, hereby declare as follows:

I am over twenty-one years of age and am competent to make this Declaration. I serve as Senior Counsel of NCI Group, Inc. ("NCI"), and my duties include managing mergers and acquisitions and the review and title records of collateralized property, including intellectual property, and the preparation of acquisition documents and ancillary agreements and refinancing of debt documents. Based on my experience in this capacity, I have personal first-hand knowledge of the facts stated within this Declaration.

NCI is now the successor in title and current owner of certain trademark registrations that were previously owned by the company H. H. Robertson Company, a Pennsylvania corporation, having an address at Two Gateway Center, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15222.

According to the records in the Assignment Division of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO"), H. H. Robertson Company granted security interests to financial institutions and said security interests were recorded with the USPTO and have not been released.

Specifically, at Reel/Frame 0675/0980 in the Assignment Division records, H. H. Robertson Company granted a security interest to First City Securities, Inc., having an address at 499 Park Ave., New York, New York 10022. The security interest was recorded in the Assignment Division of the USPTO on **October 18, 1989**. The underlying Security Interest

Agreement was not available online, as the USPTO was not scanning agreements at the time of the recordal of the security interest.

In order to locate a contact for H. H. Robertson Company to inquire about a release of the security interest recorded at the above-referenced Reel and Frame, the Pennsylvania Secretary of State records were reviewed. Upon conducting the search of the records, it was found that H. H. Robertson Company is inactive and no longer in existence. Attached as **EXHIBIT 1** is a printout from the Pennsylvania Secretary of State's Office confirming the prior statement.

Similarly, the lender, First City Securities, Inc., was also found to be no longer in existence. According to the New York Secretary of State's online records, no such entity was found in the records. Attached as **EXHIBIT 2** is a printout from the Secretary of State website confirming the same.

A search of the UCC records of the New York Secretary of State records and found no results for a filing listing H. H. Robertson Company as the Debtor. Attached hereto as **EXHIBIT 3** is a printout from the New York Secretary of State's Office confirming that no results were found in the UCC records available online.

In addition, a search was conducted on the name "First City Securities, Inc.," in the Delaware Secretary of State Office records. The search revealed a registration for "First City Securities Corporation," not First City Securities, Inc. It could not be determined whether this was the same entity or a related entity, as no other records were available because First City Securities Corporation's registration with the State had been voided in 1997 due to delinquent taxes. Attached as **EXHIBIT 4** is a copy of screenshots from the Delaware Secretary of State's Office showing the search for the entity and the status of First City Securities Corporation.

In addition to the foregoing and as another basis for releasing the security interest, according to Article 9 §515 (a) of the UCC, a filed financing statement is effective for a period of five years after the date of filing. As such, in accordance with Article 9 §515(c), the effectiveness of a filed financing statement lapses on the expiration of the period of effectiveness unless before the lapse a continuation statement is filed pursuant to subsection (d), which states that a continuation statement may be filed only within six months before the expiration of the five-year period specified in subsection (a).... Attached hereto as **EXHIBIT 5** is a copy of the relevant sections of Article 9 Section 515.

As described above, NCI has diligently tried to find the proper parties involved in the grant of the security interest and has made a good faith effort to try to obtain a release for recordal with the USPTO. However, no parties can be found that were privy to the transaction.

Further, based upon the standard operations and usual course of business in this industry, to the best of my knowledge, the property was released back to the owner, H. H. Robertson Company, as the property has passed to several owners since 1989. It is not typical for several successors in title to allow security interests to remain on the title of the collateralized property.

Due to the historical date of 1989, when the security interest was recorded, and due to the lack of documentation stating otherwise, it is our belief that the lien was removed and the property was returned to the owner, and that a release of the security interest should have been recorded with the USPTO, and we now request that the Release of Security Interest be entered.

The undersigned, being hereby warned that willful false statements and the like so made, are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. § 1001, and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the registrations that are subject to the referenced security interests, declares that he is properly authorized to execute this Declaration, and that all

statements made of his own knowledge are true; and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true.

§ 9-515. DURATION AND EFFECTIVENESS OF FINANCING STATEMENT; EFFECT OF LAPSED FINANCING STATEMENT.

(a) [Five-year effectiveness.]

Except as otherwise provided in subsections (b), (e), (f), and (g), a filed financing statement is effective for a period of five years after the date of filing.

(b) [Public-finance or manufactured-home transaction.]

Except as otherwise provided in subsections (e), (f), and (g), an initial financing statement filed in connection with a public-finance transaction or manufactured-home transaction is effective for a period of 30 years after the date of filing if it indicates that it is filed in connection with a public-finance transaction or manufactured-home transaction.

(c) [Lapse and continuation of financing statement.]

The effectiveness of a filed financing statement lapses on the expiration of the period of its effectiveness unless before the lapse a continuation statement is filed pursuant to subsection (d). Upon lapse, a financing statement ceases to be effective and any security interest or agricultural lien that was perfected by the financing statement becomes unperfected, unless the security interest is perfected otherwise. If the security interest or agricultural lien becomes unperfected upon lapse, it is deemed never to have been perfected as against a purchaser of the collateral for value.

(d) [When continuation statement may be filed.]

A continuation statement may be filed only within six months before the expiration of the five-year period specified in subsection (a) or the 30-year period specified in subsection (b), whichever is applicable.

(e) [Effect of filing continuation statement.]

Except as otherwise provided in Section 9-510, upon timely filing a continuation statement, the effectiveness of the initial financing statement continues for a period of five years commencing on the day on which
