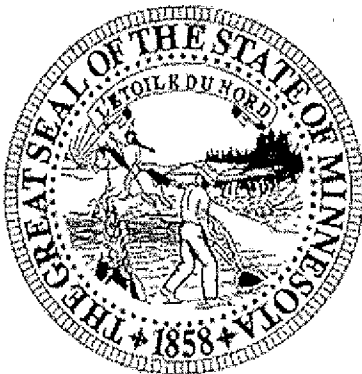

ARTICLES OF MERGER
OF
JMP INTERESTS, LLC
AND
WEST PUBLISHING CORPORATION

To the Secretary of State
State of Minnesota

Pursuant to the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act governing the merger of a foreign limited liability company into a domestic corporation for profit, the business entities hereinafter named do hereby adopt the following Articles of Merger.


1. The names of the merging business entities are JMP Interests, LLC, which is a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Texas, and West Publishing Corporation, which is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Minnesota and is subject to the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act.
2. Annexed hereto and made a part hereof is the Plan and Agreement of Merger for merging JMP Interests, LLC with and into West Publishing Corporation as set forth in a resolution approved by the affirmative vote of at least a majority of the Board of Directors of West Publishing Corporation.
3. The Plan and Agreement of Merger has been approved by West Publishing Corporation pursuant to Chapter 302A, Minnesota Statutes.
4. The laws of the jurisdiction of organization of JMP Interests, LLC permit the merger of a limited liability company of that jurisdiction with and into a corporation for profit of another jurisdiction; and the merger of JMP Interests, LLC with and into West Publishing Corporation is in compliance with the laws of the jurisdiction of organization of JMP Interests, LLC.
5. West Publishing Corporation will continue its existence as the surviving corporation under its present name pursuant to the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act.
6. The merger of JMP Interests, LLC with and into West Publishing Corporation shall become effective in the State of Minnesota on the 31st day of March 2019.

PLAN AND AGREEMENT OF MERGER approved on March 28, 2019 by JMP Interests, LLC, which is a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Texas, and by resolution adopted by its sole manager and its sole member on said date, and approved on March 28, 2019 by West Publishing Corporation, which is a corporation for profit organized under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and which is subject to the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act, and by resolution adopted by its Board of Directors and its sole shareholder on said date.

1. JMP Interests, LLC and West Publishing Corporation shall, pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Business Organizations Code and of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act, be merged with and into a single corporation, to wit, West Publishing Corporation, which shall be the surviving corporation upon the effective date of the merger and which is sometimes hereinafter referred to as the "surviving corporation", and which shall continue to exist as said surviving corporation under its present name pursuant to the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act. The separate existence of JMP Interests, LLC, which is sometimes hereinafter referred to as the "terminating limited liability company", shall cease upon the effective date of the merger in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Business Organizations Code.

2. The Articles of Incorporation of the surviving corporation upon the effective date of the merger in the State of Minnesota shall continue to be the Articles of Incorporation of said surviving corporation and shall continue in full force and effect until amended and changed in the manner prescribed by the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act.

3. The bylaws of the surviving corporation as in force and effect upon the effective date of the merger shall continue to be the bylaws of said surviving corporation and shall continue in full force and effect until changed, altered, or amended as therein provided and in the manner prescribed by the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act.

4. The directors and officers in office of the surviving corporation upon the effective date of the merger shall continue to be the members of the Board of Directors and the officers of the surviving corporation, all of whom shall hold their directorships and offices until the election and qualification of their respective successors or until their tenure is otherwise terminated in accordance with the bylaws of the surviving corporation.

5. All of the membership interest of the terminating limited liability company owned by the sole member shall, upon the effective date of the merger, be surrendered, extinguished and cancelled without consideration. The issued shares of the surviving corporation shall not be converted or exchanged in any manner, but each said share which is issued as of the effective date of the merger shall continue to represent one issued share of the surviving corporation.

6. In the event that the merger of the terminating limited liability company with and into the surviving corporation shall have been fully authorized in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Business Organizations Code and in accordance with the provisions of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act, the terminating limited liability company and the surviving corporation hereby stipulate that they will cause to be executed and filed and/or recorded any document or documents prescribed by the laws of the State of

Texas and of the State of Minnesota, and that they will cause to be performed all necessary acts therein and elsewhere to effectuate the merger.

7. The sole manager and sole member of the terminating limited liability company and the directors and officers of the surviving corporation, respectively, are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to do any and all acts and things, and to make, execute, deliver, file, and/or record any and all instruments, papers, and documents which shall be or become necessary, proper, or convenient to carry out or put into effect any of the provisions of this Plan and Agreement of Merger or of the merger herein provided for.

8. The merger herein provided for shall become effective as of the 31st day of March 2019.
