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**ASSIGNMENT OF ABL INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY
SECURITY AGREEMENT**

This ASSIGNMENT OF ABL INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (this “Assignment”), dated as of May 16, 2022, is by GOLDMAN SACHS BANK USA, as the current and resigning administrative and collateral agent (in such capacities, the “Existing Agent”) and KEYBANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, as the successor administrative and collateral agent (in such capacities, the “Successor Agent”) under that certain ABL Credit Agreement, dated as of October 10, 2018 (as amended by that certain First Amendment to ABL Credit Agreement, dated as of December 7, 2018, that certain Second Amendment to ABL Credit Agreement, dated as of April 17, 2020, that certain Third Amendment to ABL Credit Agreement, dated as of January 24, 2022, and that certain Waiver and Fourth Amendment to ABL Credit Agreement, dated as of April 1, 2022, and as further amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified on or prior to the date hereof).

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, SCM Metal Products, Inc., a Delaware corporation, READING ALLOYS, INC., a Pennsylvania corporation and AmeriTi Manufacturing, LLC, a Delaware corporation (collectively the “Grantors” and each a “Grantor”), and the Existing Agent are parties to those certain intellectual property security agreements identified on Exhibit A attached hereto (as the same have been and may hereafter be amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, collectively, the “Agreements”), which granted a security interest in the Patents and Trademarks identified on Exhibit B attached hereto to the Existing Agent; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain ABL Resignation and Assignment Agreement by and among, inter alios, the Grantors, the Existing Agent and the Successor Agent, the Existing Agent will assign to Successor Agent all of its rights, remedies, duties and other obligations under, among other documents, the Agreements, in each instance, in its capacity as administrative agent and collateral agent.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Existing Agent hereby assigns and transfers to the Successor Agent and its successors and assigns, all of its rights, title and interest in and to the Agreements.

This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Assignment by facsimile or in .pdf or similar format by electronic mail shall be effective as delivery of an original executed counterpart of this Assignment

This Assignment and the rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall be governed by, and construed and interpreted in accordance with, the law of the State of New York.


