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TERMINATION OF SECURITY INTEREST IN TRADEMARK

WHEREAS, American Iron & Metal Company Inc., a Canadian corporation with its principal place of business at 9100 Henri Bourassa Blvd. East, Montreal, Quebec, Canada H1E 2S4 (the “*Owner*”), is the owner of record of the trademark listed on the attached Exhibit “A”, now issued or pending in the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the “*Trademark*”), as evidenced by the attached Exhibit “B”; and

WHEREAS, AIM Metals & Alloys LP / AIM Metaux & Alliages S.E.C, a Canadian limited partnership with its principal place of business at 9100 Henri Bourassa Blvd. East, Montreal, Quebec, Canada H1E 2S4 (the “*Grantor*”) entered into that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated as of October 31, 2008, a true and correct copy of which was recorded at the United States Patent and Trademark Office on December 4, 2008, at Reel 3897, Frame 0778, and that certain Amended and Restated Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated as of September 20, 2011 [erroneously entered at the United States Patent and Trademark Office as being dated as of September 20, 2001], a true and correct copy of which was recorded at the United States Patent and Trademark Office on October 7, 2011, at Reel 4638, Frame 0363 (collectively, the “*Security Agreement*”), between the Grantor and The Toronto-Dominion Bank (“*Secured Party*”), wherein the Grantor did grant the Secured Party a security interest in the Trademark; and

WHEREAS, a corrective assignment to Reel 4638, Frame 0328, which alleged to correct the names of the conveying parties on that certain Reel 4638, Frame 0328, was recorded at the United States Patent and Trademark Office on October 13, 2011, at Reel 4640, Frame 0690 (“*Corrective Assignment No. 1*”), wherein the Grantor was named a conveying party; and

WHEREAS, a corrective assignment to Corrective Assignment No. 1, which clarified that Corrective Assignment No. 1 was intended to correct the names of the conveying parties in Reel 4638, Frame 0363 rather than Reel 4638, Frame 0328, was recorded at the United States Patent and Trademark Office on October 18, 2011, at Reel 4643, Frame 0671 (“*Corrective Assignment No. 2*”); and

WHEREAS, the Security Agreement, Corrective Assignment No. 1, and Corrective Assignment No. 2 together grant the Secured Party a security interest in the Trademark; and

WHEREAS, the Secured Party desires to release its security interest in the Trademark and terminate the Security Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Secured Party hereby:

1. releases and reassigns to the Grantor and/or Owner any and all liens, security interests, right, title and interest of Secured Party pursuant to the Security Agreement in the Trademark, without recourse or representation or warranty, express or implied; and
2. authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Trademarks of the United States of America to note and record the existence of the release hereby given.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Secured Party has caused this Termination of Security Interest in Trademark to be signed by its duly authorized representative as of this 5th day of August, 2022.


