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RELEASE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY INTEREST

August 17, 2022

This RELEASE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY INTEREST (this "Release") is made and effective as of the 17th day of August, 2022, and granted by Regions Bank (the "Collateral Agent") in favor of Amerex Corporation, an Alabama corporation ("Grantor").

WHEREAS, the Grantor entered into that certain Amended and Restated Credit Agreement dated October 26, 2017, among the Grantor, McWane, Inc., a Delaware corporation, the Collateral Agent, Canada Pipe Company ULC, an Alberta unlimited liability corporation, Regions Bank, as administrative agent, Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce, as Canadian Agent, and the US Lenders, the Canadian Lenders, the Swingline Lenders and the Issuing Banks that are parties thereto from time to time (as amended, restated or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement");

WHEREAS, in connection with the Credit Agreement, Grantor has executed that certain Amended and Restated Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated October 26, 2017, in favor of Collateral Agent (as amended, restated or otherwise modified from time to time, the "IP Security Agreement"), pursuant to which Grantor pledged and granted to the Collateral Parties (as defined in the IP Security Agreement) a security interest in and to certain intellectual property, including without limitation the Released IP Collateral, as hereinafter defined; and

WHEREAS, Grantor has requested that the Collateral Agent enter into this Release in order to effectuate, evidence and record the release and reassignment to the Grantor of any and all right, title and interest the Collateral Agent and the Collateral Parties may have in the Released IP Collateral pursuant to the IP Security Agreement, which security interests were recorded with the United States Patent & Trademark Office.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Collateral Agent hereby states as follows:

1. Release of Security Interest. Collateral Agent, on behalf of itself and the Collateral Parties, their successors, legal representatives and assigns, hereby terminates, releases and discharges any and all security interests that it has pursuant to the IP Security Agreement in any and all right, title and interest of Grantor, and reassigns to Grantor any and all right, title and interest that it may have, in, to and under the following (collectively, the "Released IP Collateral"):

(a) the patents, patent applications, trademarks, trademark registrations, trademark applications and tradenames listed on Exhibit A hereto, and (i) any and all renewals thereof, (ii) all income, royalties, damages and payments now or hereafter due or payable with respect thereto, including, without limitation, damages and payments for past or future infringements thereof, (iii) the right to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof, and (iv) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world (collectively, the "Patents and Trademarks");

(b) all reissues, continuations or extensions of the Patents and Trademarks;

(c) all goodwill of the Grantor's business connected with and symbolized by the Patents and Trademarks; and


(d) all products and proceeds of the foregoing, including, without limitation, any claim by the Grantor against third parties for past, present or future (i) infringement or dilution of any of the Patents and Trademarks or (ii) injury to the goodwill associated with any of the Patents and Trademarks.

2. Governing Law. This Release and any claim, controversy, dispute or cause of action (whether in contract or tort or otherwise) based upon, arising out of or relating to this release and the transactions contemplated hereby shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the State of Alabama, without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of Alabama or any other jurisdiction).




