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ASSIGNMENT EXTRACT

ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT

This Asset Purchase Agreement (this "**Agreement**"), dated effective as of January 1, 2019, is entered into by and among HPC Buyer LLC, an Idaho limited liability company ("**Buyer**"), Micro 100 Tool Corporation, an Idaho corporation ("**Seller**"), and Dale Newberry, Earl Wayne Newberry, and Ronald Newberry (each a "**Seller Owner**" and collectively, the "**Seller Owners**"). Seller and Seller Owners are together referred to as each a "**Seller Party**" and collectively, the "**Seller Parties**."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Seller is engaged in the Business (as defined herein);

WHEREAS, Seller wishes to sell, assign, transfer and convey to Buyer, and Buyer wishes to purchase from Seller, substantially all of the assets of the Business, on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth herein;

WHEREAS, the Seller Owners collectively own 100% of the equity interests of Seller and will be receiving substantial benefits from the transactions contemplated by this Agreement;

WHEREAS, simultaneously with the consummation of the transactions hereunder, and as an inducement hereto, (i) the Buyer is acquiring the real property at which the Business operates in a separate transaction pursuant to the terms and subject to the conditions of the Real Estate PSA (as defined herein), (ii) the Seller Parties and Buyer are executing and delivering the Goodwill and Restrictive Covenant Agreement (as defined herein); and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Purchase Price payable by Buyer to Seller shall be placed in escrow by Buyer, the release of which shall be contingent upon certain events and conditions, all as set forth in this Agreement and the Escrow Agreement (as defined herein).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises, the respective representations, warranties, covenants, and agreements hereinafter set forth and set forth in the other Transaction Agreements, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I DEFINITIONS

The following terms have the meanings specified or referred to in this ARTICLE I:

"**Accounts Receivable**" has the meaning set forth in Section 2.01(1).

"**Action**" means any claim, action, cause of action, demand, lawsuit, arbitration, inquiry, audit, notice of violation, proceeding, litigation, citation, summons, subpoena or investigation of any nature, civil, criminal, administrative, regulatory or otherwise, whether at law or in equity.

“**Affiliate**” of a Person means any other Person that directly or indirectly, through one or more intermediaries, controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with, such Person. The term “control” (including the terms “controlled by” and “under common control with”) means the possession, directly or indirectly, of the power to direct or cause the direction of the management and policies of a Person, whether through the ownership of voting securities, by contract or otherwise.

“**Agreement**” has the meaning set forth in the preamble.

“**Allocation Schedule**” has the meaning set forth in Section 2.07.

“**Assigned Contracts**” has the meaning set forth in Section 2.01(b).

“**Assignment and Assumption Agreement**” has the meaning set forth in Section 3.02(a)(v).

“**Assumed Liabilities**” has the meaning set forth in Section 2.03.

“**Audited Financial Statements**” has the meaning set forth in Section 4.04.

“**Balance Sheet**” has the meaning set forth in Section 4.04.

“**Balance Sheet Date**” has the meaning set forth in Section 4.04.

“**Basket**” has the meaning set forth in Section 8.04(a).

“**Benefit Plan**” has the meaning set forth in Section 4.21(a).

“**Bill of Sale**” has the meaning set forth in Section 3.02(a)(i).

“**Books and Records**” has the meaning set forth in Section Section 2.01(i).

“**Business**” means (i) the business of designing, sourcing, selling and distributing solid carbide end mills and related industrial cutting tools, including saws, mills, drills and lathe tools, in each case, as further described in any and all marketing and sales manuals and materials of Seller or any of its subsidiaries, as the same may be altered, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time, to the extent under development, sold or otherwise delivered by Seller or any of its subsidiaries at any time prior to the Closing Date and (ii) any other business conducted by Seller or any of its subsidiaries as of the Closing Date.

“**Business Day**” means any day except Saturday, Sunday or any other day on which national commercial banks located in Idaho and Massachusetts are authorized or required by Law to remain closed for business.

“**Buyer**” has the meaning set forth in the preamble.

“**Buyer Indemnitees**” has the meaning set forth in Section 8.02.

“**Cap**” has the meaning set forth in Section 8.04(a).

"Safety Requirements" means all Laws, Governmental Orders and contractual obligations concerning public health or safety, or worker health or safety.

"Self-Funded Benefit Reserve" means the amount of self-funded health benefit premiums on the Seller's balance sheet as of the Closing Date. For the avoidance of doubt, the Self-Funded Benefit Reserve shall not be included in the calculation of Closing Working Capital.

"Seller" has the meaning set forth in the preamble.

"Seller Indemnitees" has the meaning set forth in Section 8.03.

"Seller Owner" has the meaning set forth in the preamble.

"Seller Party" has the meaning set forth in the preamble.

"Seller Transaction Expenses" means the aggregate amount of all out-of-pocket fees and expenses, incurred by or on behalf of the Seller Parties or any of their respective Affiliates in connection with the negotiation, preparation or execution of this Agreement or any documents or agreements contemplated hereby or the performance or consummation of the transactions contemplated hereby or relating to bonuses, in each case, that have not been paid as of the Closing or thereafter, including (i) all fees and expenses (including fees and expenses of legal counsel, accountants, investment bankers or other professional advisors) actually incurred by the Seller in connection with the negotiation, execution and consummation of this Agreement or in connection with obtaining consents, approvals and waivers of any Person on behalf of the Seller in connection with the transactions contemplated by this Agreement, (ii) any change in control payments, sales bonus payments or similar payments made or to be made by the Seller in connection with or resulting from the Closing, together with any employment Taxes related to any of the foregoing, (iii) any fees or expenses associated with obtaining the release and termination of any Liens, (iv) all brokers' or finders' fees, and (v) fees and expenses of counsel, advisors, consultants, investment bankers, accountants, auditors and experts.

"Software" means all computer programs (whether in source code or object code form), data bases, compilers, compilations, software libraries, source code annotations, software architecture designs, layouts and development tools and the programmers' notes or logs, user, operator and training manuals or documentation, build instructions, and information related to any of the foregoing.

"Statement of Objections" has the meaning set forth in Section 2.06(c).

"Stop Loss Policy" means the Stop Loss Policy Number HCL13248 issued by HCC Life Insurance Company to Seller dated March 1, 2018..

"Tangible Personal Property" has the meaning set forth in Section 2.01(d).

"Target Closing Working Capital" means \$5,784,000.

"Taxes" means all federal, state, local, foreign and other income, gross receipts, sales, use, production, ad valorem, transfer, documentary, franchise, registration, profits, license, lease,

Section 4.11 Real Property.

(a) Seller does not own any real property.

(b) Seller has not received any written notice of (i) violations of building codes and/or zoning ordinances or other governmental or regulatory Laws affecting the Real Property, (ii) existing, pending or threatened condemnation proceedings affecting the Real Property, or (iii) existing, pending or threatened zoning, building code or other moratorium proceedings, or similar matters which could reasonably be expected to adversely affect the ability to operate the Real Property as currently operated. Neither the whole nor any material portion of any Real Property has been damaged or destroyed by fire or other casualty which remains unrepaired as of the date of this Agreement.

(c) The Real Property is sufficient for the conduct of the Business as presently conducted and constitutes all of the real property currently used by Seller to conduct the Business.

Section 4.12 Intellectual Property.

(a) Section 4.12(a) of the Disclosure Schedules lists all (i) Intellectual Property Registrations and (ii) material Intellectual Property Assets. The Seller Parties have filed and paid all appropriate filings and fees to maintain the Intellectual Property Registrations, and all Intellectual Property Registrations are otherwise in good standing. With respect to the listed Intellectual Property Registrations, each has been prosecuted or maintained, as the case may be, in reasonable compliance with all applicable rules, policies and procedures of the appropriate U.S., state or foreign registry in all material respects.

(b) Section 4.12(b) of the Disclosure Schedules lists all material Intellectual Property Agreements, which are considered Material Contracts and, except as set forth on Section 4.12(b) of the Disclosure Schedules. Seller has provided Buyer with true and complete copies of all such Intellectual Property Agreements, including all written modifications, amendments and supplements thereto and waivers thereunder. Seller has the right to assign to Buyer the Intellectual Property Agreements, and free and clear of all Encumbrances other than Permitted Encumbrances.

(c) Except as set forth in Section 4.12(c) of the Disclosure Schedules, Seller owns or has the right to use the Intellectual Property Assets, necessary for the conduct of the Business as currently conducted, in each case, free and clear of Encumbrances other than Permitted Encumbrances. Seller has not granted to any third party any exclusive rights relating to its Intellectual Property Assets.

(d) The Intellectual Property Assets and Intellectual Property licensed under the Intellectual Property Agreements are sufficient to operate the Business as currently conducted. The consummation of the transactions contemplated hereunder will not result in the loss or impairment of or payment of any additional amounts with respect to, nor require the consent of any other Person in respect of, Buyer's right to own, use or hold

for use any Intellectual Property as owned, used or held for use in the conduct of the Business as currently conducted.

(e) Seller's rights in the Intellectual Property Assets are valid, subsisting and enforceable. Seller has taken all reasonable steps to protect and preserve the confidentiality of all material trade secrets included in the Intellectual Property Assets, including requiring all Persons having access thereto to execute written non-disclosure agreements.

(f) Except as would not have a Material Adverse Effect, to the Knowledge of Seller Parties: (i) the conduct of the Business as currently conducted, and the Intellectual Property Assets currently owned by Seller, have not infringed, misappropriated, diluted or otherwise violated, and have not, and do not infringe, dilute, misappropriate or otherwise violate, the Intellectual Property or other rights of any Person, and (ii) no Person has infringed, misappropriated, diluted or otherwise violated, or is currently infringing, misappropriating, diluting or otherwise violating, any Intellectual Property Assets.

(g) There are no Actions (including any oppositions, interferences or re-examinations) settled, pending or to the Knowledge of Seller Parties threatened (including in the form of offers to obtain a license): (i) alleging any infringement, misappropriation, dilution or violation of Intellectual Property of any Person by Seller in connection with the Business as currently conducted; (ii) challenging the validity, enforceability, registrability or ownership of any Intellectual Property Assets or Seller's rights with respect to any Intellectual Property Assets; or (iii) by Seller or any other Person alleging any infringement, misappropriation, dilution or violation by any Person of any Intellectual Property Assets. Seller is not subject to any outstanding or prospective Governmental Order (including any motion or petition therefor) that does or would restrict or impair the use of any Intellectual Property Assets.

(h) Section 4.12(h) of the Disclosure Schedules identifies all material Software currently used in connection with the Business (i) owned by Seller, or (ii) licensed to Seller under the Intellectual Property Agreements. Seller owns, or has a license to use, the Software that is necessary for the Business as currently conducted, and the consummation of the transactions contemplated hereby will not conflict with any such rights or require the payment of any additional fees or amounts to any third party.

(i) Except as set forth in Section 4.12(i) of the Disclosure Schedule, to the Knowledge of Seller Parties, Seller has not embedded, linked to or otherwise incorporated any Software (in source or object code form) licensed from another party under a license commonly referred to as an open source, free software, copyleft or community source code license corresponding to the requirements defined in the Open Source Definition (available on the URL: <http://opensource.org/osd>) by the Open Source Initiative, or by the Free Software Foundation (available on the URL: http://www.fsf.org/?set_language=fr), (such software "Open Source Software") in any Software owned by Seller or in development in a manner that obligates Seller to disclose,

make available, offer or deliver the source code of any Software owned by Seller other than such Open Source Software.

(j) Seller is in compliance in all material respects, with all: (a) applicable Laws, (b) contractual obligations, (c) internal and public-facing privacy and/or security policies of Seller, (d) public statements that Seller has made regarding its respective privacy and/or data security policies or practices, and (e) applicable published industry standards relating to the collection, use, storage, retention, disclosure, transfer, disposal, or any other processing of any private or protected information collected or used by the Business. There is no complaint to, or any audit, proceeding, claim, or investigation (formal or informal) currently pending against Seller by any private party, the Federal Trade Commission, any state attorney general or similar state official, or any other governmental entity, foreign or domestic, with respect to Seller's collection, use, retention, disclosure, transfer, storage or disposal of private or protected information. Seller has taken commercially reasonable steps to protect such private or protected information against loss and against unauthorized access, use, modification, disclosure or other misuse.

Section 4.13 Inventory. All Inventory, whether or not reflected in the Interim Balance Sheet, consists of a quality and quantity usable and salable in the ordinary course of business consistent with past practice, except for obsolete, damaged, defective or slow-moving items that have been written off or written down to fair market value or for which adequate reserves have been established. All Inventory is owned by Seller free and clear of all Encumbrances, and no Inventory is held on a consignment basis. The quantities of each item of Inventory (whether raw materials, work-in-process or finished goods) are not excessive, but are reasonable in the present circumstances of Seller.

Section 4.14 Accounts Receivable. The Accounts Receivable reflected on the Interim Balance Sheet and the Accounts Receivable arising after the date thereof (a) have arisen from bona fide transactions entered into by Seller involving the sale of goods or the rendering of services in the ordinary course of business consistent with past practice; and (b) constitute only valid, undisputed claims of Seller not subject to claims of set-off or other defenses or counterclaims other than normal cash discounts accrued in the ordinary course of business consistent with past practice. The reserve for bad debts shown on the Interim Balance Sheet or, with respect to Accounts Receivable arising after the Interim Balance Sheet Date, on the accounting records of the Business have been determined in accordance with GAAP, consistently applied, subject to normal year-end adjustments and the absence of disclosures normally made in footnotes.

Section 4.15 Suppliers and Customers.

(a) Section 4.15(a) of the Disclosure Schedules sets forth with respect to the Business (i) each supplier to whom Seller has paid consideration for goods or services rendered in an amount greater than or equal to \$25,000 for the most recent fiscal year (collectively, the "Material Suppliers"); and (ii) the amount of purchases from each Material Supplier during such period. Except as set forth on Section 4.15(a) of the Disclosure Schedules, Seller has not received any notice, and has no reason to believe,



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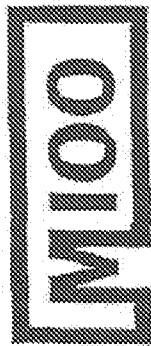
