**AMENDED AND RESTATED
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

SCIENCE HISTORY INSTITUTE

FIRST: The name of the corporation is SCIENCE HISTORY INSTITUTE.

SECOND: The location and post office address of its office is 315 Chestnut Street Philadelphia, COUNTY OF PHILADELPHIA PA 19106-2702

THIRD: The purpose for which the Science History Institute (the "Corporation") is organized and operated is exclusively for educational and scientific purposes as defined in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). The Corporation shall receive, hold and administer funds and disburse them for the advancement of the history of chemistry, chemical engineering, the life sciences, and related sciences and technologies. The Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise.

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FOURTH: The term for which the corporation shall exist is perpetual.

FIFTH: The corporation is organized upon a nonstock basis.

SIXTH: The members of the corporation shall be the American Chemical Society, the American Institute of Chemical Engineers, and such other organizations as the members may from time to time elect as provided for in the bylaws of the corporation.

SEVENTH: No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

EIGHTH: If in any one year the corporation is determined to be a private foundation, then, in that event, its income for each such taxable year shall be distributed at such time and in such manner as not to subject the foundation to tax under Section 4942 of the Code, and the foundation shall not engage in self-dealing (as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code) and shall not make any investments in such a manner as to subject the foundation to tax under Section

4944 of the Code, and shall not make any taxable expenditures (as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code).

NINTH: In the event of dissolution or termination of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the objectives of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the board of directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction exclusively for such purposes, or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine are organized and operated expressly for such purposes.
