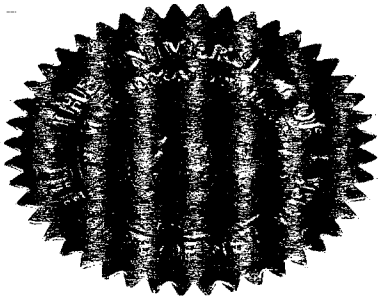
ORDER OF MERGER

This Instrument Witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York at their meeting of January 14, 2020,

An application having been made on behalf of the trustees of National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center and National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center Foundation, Inc., to rescind the October 8, 2019 action of the Board of Regents merging the two corporations, it was

Voted, that the order of merger granted October 8, 2019 by the Board of Regents be, and the same hereby is, amended *nunc pro tunc* to October 8, 2019

1. Pursuant to the authority contained in Education Law §223, National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center and the National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center Foundation, Inc. be, and hereby are, merged under the name National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center.
2. The principal office of the merged corporation shall be located at 200 Liberty Street, 16th Floor, New York, New York 10281.
3. National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center, the surviving corporation will continue to administer the educational operations and purposes of the constituent corporations in the same manner as they presently exist.
4. The separate existence of the constituent corporation, National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center Foundation, Inc. hereby ceases, and the surviving corporation is hereby vested with all the rights, privileges, immunities, powers and authority possessed by or granted by law to each of the constituent corporations. All assets and liabilities of the respective constituent corporations are hereby assets and liabilities of the surviving corporation. All property, real, personal and mixed and all debts to each of the constituent corporations on whatever account are hereby attached to the surviving corporation and may be enforced against it to the same extent as if the debts, liabilities and duties had been incurred or contracted by it.
5. The Commissioner of Education is designated as the representative of the corporation upon whom process in any action or proceeding against it may be served.
6. The merger herein shall be effective December 31, 2019 at 11:59pm.
7. The merged corporation will operate under the absolute charter granted to National September 11 Memorial and Museum at the World Trade Center, the surviving corporation.
