GENERAL CONVEYANCE

REXDALE ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT

THIS INDENTURE made the 23rd day of February, 1998.

BY:

CANRON INC.

a corporation existing under the laws
of Canada,

(hereinafter referred to as "Seller"),

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement of purchase and sale made as of the date hereof

between 3409848 Canada Inc. (the "Purchaser") and the Seller (the "Rexdale Asset Purchase Agreement"), the Seller agreed to sell, and the Purchaser agreed to purchase, effective as of 12:01 a.m. on the date hereof the Assets (as defined in the Rexdale Asset Purchase Agreement);

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSES that for good and valuable consideration now paid by the Purchaser to the Seller (the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged) the Seller hereby sells, assigns, transfers, conveys and sets over unto the Purchaser, its successors and assigns, and the Purchaser, its successors and assigns, hereby purchases, on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth in the Rexdale Asset Purchase Agreement, including, without limitation, the representations and warranties made in favour of the Purchaser in such agreement on the terms and subject to the conditions contained therein including with respect to survival, all of which provisions shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with their respective terms, as at and from 12:01 a.m. on the date hereof, the Assets, many of which Assets are set forth upon Exhibits 1A, 1B, 1C, 1F, and 1J to the Rexdale Asset Purchase Agreement.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said hereby sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed Assets and all right, title, benefit and interest of the Seller thereto and therein unto and to the use of the Purchaser, its successors and assigns.

AND the Seller hereby covenants, promises and agrees with the Purchaser as follows:

1. the Seller will from time to time and at all times hereafter, upon every reasonable request of the Purchaser, its successors or assigns, make, do or execute or cause and procure to be made done and executed, all such further acts, deeds or assurances as may be reasonably required by the Purchaser, its successors or assigns, whether for more effectually or completely vesting from

the Purchaser, its successors or assigns, the Assets hereby sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed in accordance with the terms hereof and the Rexdale Asset Purchase Agreement or for the purpose of registration or otherwise.

2. the Seller hereby declares that, as to any Asset or interest in any of the Assets of the Seller intended to be transferred, assigned, conveyed and set over to the Purchaser, its successors and assigns, and title to which may not have passed to the Purchaser, its successors and assigns, by virtue of this indenture or any transfers or conveyances which may from time to time be executed and delivered in pursuance of the covenants aforesaid, the Seller holds the same in trust for the Purchaser, its successors and assigns.

This indenture will be governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario, Canada.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF this indenture has been executed by the Seller.


