ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK
AND PENDING TRADEMARK REGISTRATION APPLICATION

WHEREAS, on or about April 28, 1995, Greenspring Computers, Inc., a corporation of the State of California having a place of business at 181 Constitution Drive, Menlo Park, CA 94025 (formerly located at 1204 O'Brien Drive, Menlo Park, CA) (hereinafter "Greenspring") and SBS Technologies, Inc., a New Mexico corporation having a place of business at 181 Constitution Drive, Menlo Park, CA 94025 (hereinafter "SBS") concluded an agreement transferring certain assets (sometimes called the "Greenspring CPE business assets" and hereinafter called the "Transferred Assets") to SBS in return for consideration paid to Greenspring, the Transferred Assets including the trademark "IndustryPack and Design" and all associated trademark rights, trademark applications and goodwill;


WHEREAS Greenspring is the owner of the trademark "IndustryPack and Design" for certain products, February 9, 1993 received United States Trademark Registration No. 1,751,110 for that mark in connection with an "electronic circuits, circuit boards, electronic circuit modules with circuits mounted therein" (in International Class 9);

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of confirming title in and to SBS as well as executing a document suitable for recording at the United States Patent and Trademark Office to record title in and to the IndustryPack and Design trademark;

NOW, THEREFORE, TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, effective as of April 28, 1995, be it known that for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Greenspring hereby acknowledges that it has assigned to SBS all right, title and interest in and to the "IndustryPack and Design" trademark, the U.S. trademark Registration No. 1,751,110, and all corresponding world-wide foreign rights, in all countries, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the IndustryPack and

Design trademark and the aforementioned U.S. trademark registration and the right to sue for past infringements thereof and to all damages in connection therewith.
