

ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT FOR TRADEMARKS

THIS ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT FOR TRADEMARKS ("Assignment"), is made on the 30th day of September, 1999, by and between Hunter Industries Incorporated, a Delaware corporation ("Buyer"), and Glen-Hilton Products, Inc., a New Jersey corporation ("Seller").

WHEREAS, Seller is the sole owner of the entire and exclusive rights, title and interest in the trademarks, trademark applications and trade names (collectively the "Trademarks") set forth in Schedule 1.1.3(b) attached hereto relating to the design, manufacture and sale of a rain sensing device known as the "Mini-Clik II" as well as wind and freeze sensing devices, mini-weather stations, a wireless rain sensor, and related accessory items, all used in connection with irrigation systems, and any and all goodwill associated therewith.

WHEREAS, Seller has agreed to sell and Buyer has agreed to buy said Trademarks pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated September 30, 1999 ("Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE, for a good and valuable consideration paid by Buyer to Seller the receipt and sufficiency of which hereby acknowledged, Seller agrees to sell, assign, transfer and set over and does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to Buyer, the entire right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks together with all goodwill associated therewith, including any renewals or extensions of the Trademarks now or hereafter in effect, and including the subject matter of all claims which may be obtained therefrom, for Buyer's own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by the Seller if this Assignment and sale had not been made, together with all income, royalties or payments that are or become due or payable on or after the Closing Date (as such term is defined in the Agreement), including all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement or other unauthorized use, with the right to sue for and collect the same for Buyer's use and enjoyment and the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.

Seller authorizes and requests the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to record Buyer as assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks and the goodwill associated therewith.






