Dear Mr. Jordan:

This is a correction to our letter of May 6, 1999 to your credit union. In this letter, we did not include the full name of your credit union, Schools Financial Credit Union. Please retain this letter as a replacement for the erroneous one.

We received evidence Schools Federal Credit Union is authorized to operate as Schools Financial Credit Union, a State of California chartered credit union as of April 1, 1999.

We canceled your charter and federal share insurance certificate, Charter No. 24317, effective April 1, 1999. Please keep these documents as they may be needed for reference at a later date in connection with actions taken prior to the conversion.

Enclosed is the share insurance certificate, Insurance No. 68398. Display this certificate in the credit union office, and use this number on all reports and correspondence exchanged with this agency.

Please note, Chapter 4, Section III.G of NCUA's Interpretive Ruling and Policy Statement 99-1 state the converting credit union shall neither use the words "Federal Credit Union" in its name, nor represent itself in any manner as being a federal credit union. Section 740.2 of NCUA's Rules and Regulations states no federally insured credit union can make any representation which is inaccurate or deceptive. As a newly chartered state credit union, you and the other officials are responsible for complying with these requirements.
