Pursuant to the provisions in §607.1003 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation hereby adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation pursuant to the written action of a majority of the Corporation's shareholders on February 15, 2000, pursuant to §607.0704, FLA. STAT. (1998).

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporate is e-Builder, Inc.

2. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 9,277,925 shares of common stock. The number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 9,277,925 shares of common stock.

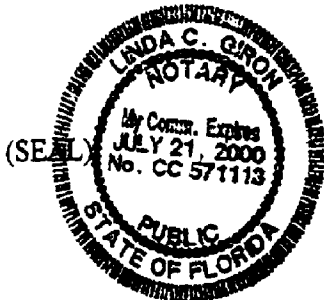
