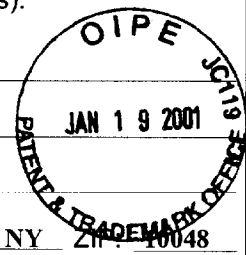

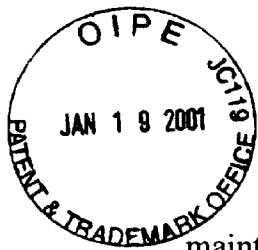
SERVICEMARK ASSIGNMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT dated this 9th day of January, 2001, from Marine Index Bureau, Inc., a New Jersey corporation having an address of 195 Clarksville Road, Princeton Junction, New Jersey 08550 (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), to ISO Services, Inc., a Delaware corporation, having an address of 7 World Trade Center, New York, New York 10048 (hereinafter referred to as "Assignee");

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement dated January 9, 2001, certain assets, tangible and intangible, of Assignor were transferred to Assignee, including the servicemark listed in Exhibit A hereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency whereof is hereby acknowledged, Assignor has agreed to and has assigned, transferred and set over and does hereby sell, assign, transfer, convey and set over unto the said Assignee and its successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in and to the servicemark listed in Exhibit A, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the servicemark, and the common law rights thereto, to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee, and its successors and assigns, for their own use and enjoyment, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor if this assignment and sale had not been made, including, without limitation, the right to



maintain and renew the registration of the servicemark, the right to recover for past infringement and to make application or institute suit therefore.

The Assignor hereby authorizes the Assignee to apply for and obtain the recordation of this Assignment. The Assignor agrees that it shall, without further consideration, promptly and duly cause to be performed such lawful acts and execution of any other documents as the Assignee may reasonably request in order for the Assignee to obtain the full benefit of this Assignment and to permit the Assignee to be duly recorded in each office, bureau and tribunal in the appropriate jurisdiction as the registered owner or proprietor of each of the rights hereby assigned. Such instruments and documents shall include, without limitation, affidavits, including affidavits of use, and other documents for filing in such jurisdictions as the Assignee may from time to time reasonably request.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Assignor has caused this assignment to be executed by its proper officer thereunto duly authorized, and its corporation seal to be affixed by like authority, this 9th day of January, 2001.


