

**AGREEMENT TO
CONDITIONALLY ASSIGN ALL RIGHTS IN THE TRADEMARK
"CIEBA"**

This agreement is made by and between the Association for Financial Professionals ("AFP"), a Delaware Nonprofit Corporation and the Executive Committee of CIEBA, Inc., a New York Nonprofit Corporation, this first day of June 2000.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Investments of Employee Benefit Assets, an incorporated association, ("CIEBA", became a committee within AFP.)

WHEREAS the Executive Committee of CIEBA, Inc., filed an Intent to Use application for registration with the United States Patent and Trademark Office, Application No. _____, "CIEBA" (the "Mark"), application received April 28, 2000; and,

WHEREAS the Executive Committee of CIEBA, Inc. assigned the application for the Mark, and the subsequent registration and use thereof to AFP; and


WHEREAS the members of the Executive Committee of CIEBA, Inc., are also members of the Executive Committee of CIEBA, and

WHEREAS AFP desires to complete the application process, acquire and use the Mark upon registration thereof;


IT IS AGREED THAT for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, should at a later date the members of the Executive Committee of CIEBA completely disaffiliate with AFP, AFP will

- (i) cease its use of the Mark and assign all rights in the Mark to whatever entity the Executive Committee of CIEBA identifies, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Mark and the registration thereof,
- (ii) remove the AFP designation from all publications, databases and URL names associated with CIEBA and cease its use of all such CIEBA property, and
- (iii) transfer all CIEBA reserves to whatever entity the Executive Committee of CIEBA identifies.

It is also agreed that AFP shall use the Mark solely in connection with the business and activities of CIEBA, as authorized by the CIEBA Executive Committee.


