ASSIGNMENT OF REGISTERED MARK

WHEREAS, Digital Realms, Inc. (“Assignor”), a Texas corporation with principal offices at 124B Commercial Ave, Lowell, Arkansas, 72745, was the Applicant for federal registration for the mark, BATTLESTORM (the “Mark”), said application being given Serial No. 75/775,508 at the United States Patent and Trademark Office (“USPTO”); and

WHEREAS, by separate agreement, The AEGIS Technologies Group, Inc. (the “Assignee”), an Alabama corporation with principal offices at 6703 Odyssey Drive, Suite 200, Huntsville, Alabama 35806, entered into a transaction with Assignor in which Assignee purchased certain assets of Assignor, including all rights, title, and interest to the BATTLESTORM mark (the “Mark”), the product associated with the Mark, and the right to provide services in conjunction with the use of the Mark; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the execution of said Asset Purchase Agreement, and the transfer of all rights contemplated thereunder, the Mark obtained registration at the USPTO on December 18, 2001, said Registration Number being 2,520,842; and

WHEREAS, the goods and services associated with the Mark and as described in the Registration Certificate are, “computer education training services”, in International Class 41, and, “computer game software”, in International Class 9; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the full and effective transfer of all rights in the Mark, the goodwill associated with the Mark, and all past or future common law causes of action related to the Mark, the Assignor desires to execute this Assignment of Registered Mark.

NOW, THEREFOR, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignor does hereby sell, convey, assign, transfer and deliver to the Assignee, its successors and assigns, its entire right, title and interest in and to the Mark and the registration thereof, together with the goodwill of the businesses symbolized by the Mark, and all past common law causes of action.

Assignor represents and warrants that it has not conveyed any rights whatsoever to any third person or entity in and to the Mark.


