CERTIFICATE OF
AMENDMENT TO THE
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ABCO, INC.

Patrick Culpepper, President, and Stephen E. Yoder, Secretary, of ABCO, INC., an Ohio corporation, with its principal office located in Canton, Stark County, do hereby certify that a meeting of the holders of all of the voting shares of stock of said Corporation entitling them to vote on the proposal to amend the Articles of Incorporation thereof, as contained in the following resolutions, was duly called and held on the 15th day of February 2002, at which meeting said Shareholders unanimously voted to adopt the following resolution to amend the Articles:

RESOLVED, that Article First and Article Third are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following Article First and Article Third:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation shall be **PROGRESSIVE FOAM TECHNOLOGIES, INC.**

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which it is formed are:

To manufacture and produce Foam related products and to develop new technology and products for commercial and other purposes.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, or otherwise, to own, hold, use, manage, develop, plat, mortgage, invest in and to sell, lease, mortgage, exchange, and otherwise deal in real estate and any interest or right therein.

To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, sell, assign, transfer, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of, and to invest, trade, deal in or deal with goods, wares and merchandise and personal property, of every class and description.

To apply for, obtain, purchase, take licenses in respect of or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, use, grant licenses in respect of, manufacture under, sell, assign, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of: any and all

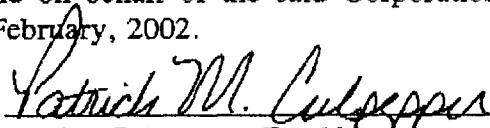
inventions, devices, processes and any improvements and modifications thereof; and any and all letters patent of the United States or of any other country, state, territory or locality, and all rights connected therewith or appertaining thereunto; any and all copyrights granted by the United States or any other country, state, territory or locality; and any and all trademarks, trade names, trade symbols and other indications of origin and ownership granted by or recognized under the laws of the United States or of any other country, state, territory, or locality.


Each purpose specified in any clause or paragraph contained in this Article Third shall be deemed to be independent of all other purposes herein specified and shall not be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of these Articles of Incorporation.

The purpose, along with the other above set forth specified purposes, is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be formed under Sections 1701.01 to 1701.98 inclusive of the Revised Code.

The foregoing enumeration of purposes shall also be construed both as objects and powers and it is expressly provided that such enumeration of specific objects and powers shall in no way limit or restrict the powers of the corporation in any manner whatsoever.
