**TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that:

WHEREAS, pursuant to an instrument dated March 2, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the "Trust Instrument"), HOWARD LINDSAY created a trust (hereinafter referred to as the "Trust") for the benefit of his wife DOROTHY S. LINDSAY (hereinafter referred to as the "Decedent") and, upon her death, for the benefit of certain other beneficiaries; and

WHEREAS, Howard Lindsay died on February 11, 1968; and

WHEREAS, the Trust Instrument granted the Decedent a power of appointment, to be exercised in her will, with respect to the disposition of literary property held by the part of the Trust known as a marital trust (hereinafter referred to as the "Part I Trust") at the date of her death; and

WHEREAS, the Decedent died on June 2, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Part I Trust held fifty-six and seven-tenths percent (56.7%) of the entire literary property interests held by the Trust at the date of Decedent's death (hereinafter referred to as the "Part I Proportion"); and

WHEREAS, Decedent's Last Will and Testament (hereinafter referred to as the "Will") (i) appointed the undersigned JEREMY NUSSBAUM as Executor of her Estate; and (ii) exercised said power of appointment directing ANNA E. CROUSE and JEREMY NUSSBAUM (hereinafter referred to as the "Trustees"), as sole trustees of the Trust, to distribute the Part I Proportion to the Assignor as Executor, and the Trustees, by executing this instrument, confirm that they have done so; and

WHEREAS, Article SIXTH of the Will specifically provided that the Part I Proportion be bequeathed to ANNA E. CROUSE, LINDSAY ANN CROUSE and TIMOTHY CROUSE (hereinafter referred to as the "Assignees"); and

WHEREAS, the Trust, has adopted, used and is using and is a co-owner of the following trademarks now registered in the United States Patent and Trademark Office:




