ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS IN *PIRATES!*
FROM ATARI INTERACTIVE, INC. TO FIRAXIS GAMES, INC.

COMES NOW, ATARI Interactive, Inc. [50 Dunham Road, Beverly, MA 01915] (p.k.a., Infogrames Interactive, Inc.) ("ATARI") and hereby sells, transfers, assigns and conveys certain rights to Firaxis Games, Inc. [11350 McCormick Road, Executive Plaza III; Suite 1100, Hunt Valley, MD 21031] ("Firaxis"), as set forth herein.

WHEREAS Microprose Software, Inc. ("Microprose") owned all copyrights, trademarks, and other rights (including, but not limited to, all U.S. and foreign: patents; trade secrets; Technology¹; trademarks, trade names, and accompanying good will; copyrights; moral rights; designs; rights of publicity; mask work rights; utility models; and other industrial or intangible rights of a similar nature), hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Intellectual Property," in any and all versions, ports, expansion packs, packaging and manuals of the video game title Pirates! (a.k.a. Sid Meier's Pirates!) in all formats and media (the "Work Product").

WHEREAS Microprose registered certain of its copyrights and trademarks in many, if not all, of the elements for which such protection is available in the Work Product with the United States Copyright Office and the United States Patent and Trademark Office. Such registrations are listed in the attached Schedule A (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Registered Works").

WHEREAS ATARI has acquired by written transfer from Microprose all Intellectual Property rights in the Work Product.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is the intent and understanding of ATARI and Firaxis that one hundred percent (100%) of the interest in the Intellectual Property rights which exist in the specified Work Product,

¹ "**Technology**" shall mean all discoveries, inventions, writings, know-how, designs, techniques, methods, formulae, algorithms, procedures and all acknowledge or other information, whether or not the subject matter thereof is patentable, copyrightable or eligible for mask work protection, which are incorporated in or used in designing, developing or modifying the Work Product or any hardware or software component thereof, or are known or become known to Firaxis and are useful in connection therewith, excluding subject matter in the public domain as of the date hereof or which hereafter enters the public domain through no fault of Firaxis.

The assignments in this document shall not effect nor limit ATARI's license to exploit the Work Product as agreed upon by the parties in their agreement dated October 21, 2002, as amended.

ATARI warrants that: a) ATARI actually owns the Intellectual Property rights in the Work Product; b) ATARI received the Intellectual Property rights in the Work Product by valid transfer from Microprose; c) ATARI has the right to assign the Intellectual Property rights in the Work Product to Firaxis, and that by doing so, ATARI will not be violating the rights of any third party; d) the Work Product does not infringe on the Intellectual Property rights of any third party; e) the Intellectual Property rights in the Work Product have not been mortgaged, encumbered, pledged, or otherwise rendered subject to a lien for the purpose of securing the payment of money or the performance of an obligation; and f) Firaxis shall not be required to obtain any third-party licenses or permission in order to use, license, sublicense or assign the Work Product or the Intellectual Property rights therein.

ATARI agrees to indemnify Firaxis from any and all claims, damages, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising from any breach of this Agreement, the warranties herein, or from any third party claim alleging a breach of the warranties.

Good and valuable consideration has been given to the undersigned for the assignment of these rights, and all other rights herein.

I, having the authority to bind the party for whom I sign, have read and understood the terms of this assignment and agree that I and/or my company shall abide by them as evidence from my signature below.
