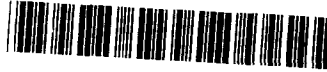





Assignor further assigns to Assignee all right to sue for and receive all damages accruing from past infringement of the trademark and the trademark registration assigned herein.


