REGAN, a United States citizen residing at 1201 Hartford Court, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23464 (hereinafter "Assignor"), is the owner of the trademark AIR-A-PLANE for "portable air cooling and heating units adapted for connection to an airplane while the latter is stationary; air cooling and heating units attached to the airport terminal bridge for connection to an airplane while the latter is stationary" and of U.S. Trademark Registration No. 1,919,532 therefor in the United States Patent and Trademark Office (hereinafter "the Mark"); and

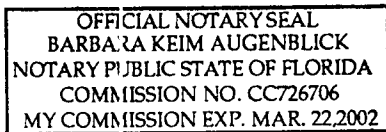

RESPONSE TO POST REGISTRATION OFFICE ACTION

On April 26, 2006, the Examiner issued a Post Registration Office Action with regard Illinois Tool Works Inc.'s ("ITW" or the "Registrant") Registration No. 1,919,532 for "AIR-A-PLANE," rejecting Registrants Section 8 Affidavit filed on September 15, 2005 due to an apparent break in the chain of title to Registrant.

In the Post Registration Office Action, the Examiner explained that there is a break in the chain of title, because the USPTO records do not show that Reg. No. 1,919,532 was assigned from Trilectron Industries, Inc. (a Florida corporation) to Trilectron Industries, Inc. (a Delaware corporation). It is believed that the Examiner meant to say that the USPTO records do not show that Reg. No. 1,919,532 was assigned from Trilectron Industries, Inc. (a Florida corporation) to Trilectron Industries, Inc. (a New York corporation), because there is no reference to Trilectron of Delaware in any of the assignment documents or in the USPTO's assignment records.

By way of explanation, while an error was made when recording a past assignment of Reg. No. 1,919,532, there was no break in the chain of title to ITW. The assignment record indicates that Reg. No. 1,919,532 was assigned from Ms. Lynette Regan to Trilectron Industries, Inc. (a Florida corporation), and then from Trilectron Industries, Inc. (a New York corporation)



to ITW. Thus, there appears to be a break in the chain of title between Trilectron (a Florida corporation) and Trilectron (a New York corporation). However, there is no break, because Ms. Regan mistakenly referred to Trilectron as a Florida corporation, when she should have referred to Trilectron as a New York corporation. Trilectron Industries, Inc. had always been a New York corporation, and there is no "Trilectron Industries, Inc." organized under the laws of the State of Florida. The Registrant believes that Ms. Regan made this mistake because Trilectron was *located* in Florida, although it was organized under the laws of the State of New York and .

The Post Registration Office Action indicates that the Registrant can respond to the Office Action by (1) submitting to directly to the Paralegal a Declaration explaining the transfer of legal title verified with a signed Declaration under 37 C.F.R. § 2.20; or (2) recording the appropriate documents with the Assignment Division and notifying the Examiner of the recordal.

Accordingly, the Registrant responds to the Post Registration Office Action by submitting the attached Declaration, by recording a Corrective Assignment form with the Assignment Division of the USPTO, and by paying the required fee to correct the record of assignment.

DECLARATION UNDER 37 C.F.R. §§ 2.20

I, William C. Bamford, being hereby warned that willful false statements and the like are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. 1001, and that such willful false statements and the like may jeopardize the validity of this document or of U.S. Registration No. 1,919,532, declare that all statements are made of my own knowledge are true, and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true.

1. I am the General Manager of GSE Commercial, a division of the Hobart Brothers Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of Illinois Tool Works Inc. ("ITW"). ITW owns Reg. No. 1,919,532. This document is being submitted to explain the chain of title resulting in ITW's ownership of Reg. No. 1,919,532.
2. As of January 2000, an individual by the name of Lynnette H. Regan owned Reg. No. 1,919,532.
3. On February 1, 2000, Ms. Regan assigned the entire interest and goodwill in Reg. No. 1,919,532 to Trilectron Industries, Inc. pursuant to a trademark assignment agreement (the "First Agreement"). (Attached as Ex. 1). Due to an oversight, the First Agreement incorrectly listed Trilectron as a Florida corporation - the agreement should have stated that Trilectron is a New York corporation. It is believed that the error was made because Trilectron is *located* in Florida. However, Trilectron has never been a Florida corporation.

4. The First Agreement was recorded with the USPTO, so the USPTO's assignment records list an assignment from Ms. Regan to Trilectron Industries, Inc. (Florida corporation), when in fact, the records should list an assignment to Trilectron Industries, Inc. (New York corporation).
5. Trilectron Industries, Inc. was subsequently acquired by the Hobart Brothers Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of ITW.
6. On September 14, 2000, Trilectron assigned the entire interest and goodwill in Reg. No. 1,919,532 to ITW pursuant to a trademark assignment agreement (the "Second Agreement"). (Attached as Ex. B). The Second Agreement correctly states that Trilectron is a New York corporation.
7. The Second Agreement was recorded with the USPTO, so the USPTO's assignment records correctly list an assignment from Trilectron Industries, Inc., a New York corporation, to ITW.
8. Consequently, there appears to be a break in the chain of title, because no assignment from Trilectron (Florida) to Trilectron (New York) was ever recorded. However, Trilectron (Florida) never existed.
9. The corporate entity of Trilectron Industries, Inc. (New York) was subsequently dissolved, so this entity no longer exists. However, both the "TRILECTRON" name and the "AIR-A-PLANE" mark are still used by subsidiaries of ITW.
10. In summary, Reg. No. 1,919,532 was legally assigned from Ms. Regan to Trilectron Industries, Inc., a New York corporation, and then it was legally assigned from Trilectron Industries, Inc., a New York corporation, to ITW.
