This letter is the official certification of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) to merge Mesa National Bank and American National Bank into Western National Bank. This merger will be effective close of business February 13, 2004. The title of the resulting bank shall be American National Bank, Denver, Colorado, and the charter number shall be 15383.

This is also the official authorization given to American National Bank, Denver, Colorado to operate the branches of the target institutions and the main offices of the target institutions as branches. A listing of the three newly authorized branches and their assigned OCC branch numbers are as follows:

If a branch is closed, a copy of this authorization must be returned with the effected branch(es) highlighted and marked closed. If a branch is closed, you must follow the "Notice of Branch Closing" requirements of Section 228 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation Improvement Act of 1991, which was effective on December 19, 1991.

This letter is also the official authorization of the OCC given to American National Bank, Charter Number 15383, to increase its capital surplus from \$29,852,875.00 to \$52,707,796.00 as a result of the merger. The proceeds may be considered as capital, effective February 13, 2004.

The bank should change its legal lending limit calculation as of the effective date. In addition, all other statutory limits based on resulting capital changed on the respective date.

If the combination does not occur as represented in your letter of January 20, 2004, this certification must be returned to the OCC.
