Articles of Incorporation
American Institute of Implant Dentistry

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as Incorporators, of a corporation under the NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT (D.C. Code 2001 edition, Title 29, Chapter 3), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST

The name of the corporation is: American Institute of Implant Dentistry Foundation.

SECOND:

The corporation's period of duration is perpetual.

THIRD:

The corporation is organized as a corporation exempt from federal tax under Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code and as a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of District of Columbia.

Its purposes are:

To promote postgraduate educational resources to general dentists, specialists and the auxiliary teams of such dentists. The corporation will seek to facilitate the best patient care possible. Through a team of faculty members, international local directors and scientific contributors the corporation will seek to bring the American Standard of continuing education to the global dental arena. With this multi-national approach, it will

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be able to provide education that can be tailored to best assist different regions of the world. The corporation will encourage lifetime learning through constant advancements in the dental industry through research, including, but not limited to implantology, as well as creating open forums for dental professionals to interact with their colleagues of different educational backgrounds & experiences.

An additional goal is to equip dental professionals with the tools necessary to provide the highest level of care possible, but also provide patients the resources to educate themselves about different treatment options. To employ the most current trends & technology in implantology we consult with leading implant manufacturers to provide suggestions to better facilitate a patient's needs.

The corporation seeks to educate the public on different treatment modalities as well. The corporation will be able to provide patients and clinicians with the tools to help them better understand different treatment options utilizing tissue engineering and reconstructive approaches from a basic dentoalveolar problem to the most extensive cases, including trauma victims and cancer patients. The corporation will extend all of its resources to make sure clinicians and patients will achieve their goals of long-term success.

The corporation will seek to be a dependable resource for both dental professionals & patients alike. Dental professionals know that whenever they take a course with the corporation they will receive researched, current scientific education; education that is recognized by such organizations as The American Dental Association & The Academy of General Dentistry as meeting rigorous educational standards. On the other hand, patients are able to utilize the corporation's resources for educating themselves regarding different treatment modalities and their effects on their long-term oral health.

In addition to the above, the corporation shall have all powers necessary and requisite and lawful to accomplish the purposes of this organization consistent with the provisions of §29-301.04 DC Code and as that section may be amended from time to time.

RESTRICTIONS: The corporation is not organized for profit or organized to engage in an activity ordinarily carried on for profit. No part of the net earnings or assets of the non-profit corporation will inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its director, officers or any other private persons. The non-profit corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Articles of Incorporation.

The corporation will be supported by membership dues and other income from activities substantially related to its exempt purpose.

No part of the activities of the non-profit corporation may include the carrying on of propaganda or be used to influence legislation as defined in Section 4945 of the Internal Revenue Code. The non-profit corporation may not participate in, or intervene in

(including the publishing or distributions of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The non-profit corporation may not exercise any power or engage directly or indirectly in any activity that would invalidate its status as a corporation exempt from federal income taxation:

FOURTH:

The corporation will have no members.

FIFTH:

Successor directors to the initial directors will be nominated, elected and appointed by the existing directors of the corporation.

SIXTH:

The Board of Directors will have authority for all internal affairs of the corporation and may exercise all powers of the corporation as permitted by federal law, state law, the Articles of Incorporation, and the By-Laws of the corporation as in effect from time to time.

The number of directors to constitute the first Board of Directors is five. After this initial Board of Directors is organized, it may change the number of director in the manner provided in the By-Laws and consistent with the laws of the District of Columbia to no less than three and no more than seven.

Dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation shall be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of §29-301.48 DC Code, or in accordance with the plan of dissolution undertaken by the Board of Directors in accordance with the provisions of §29-301.49 DC Code.

SEVENTH:

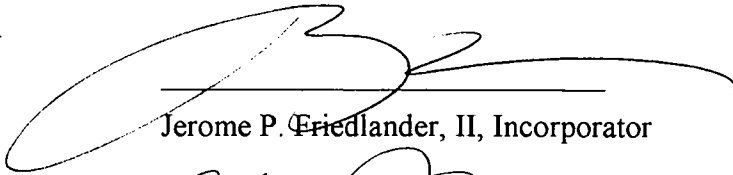

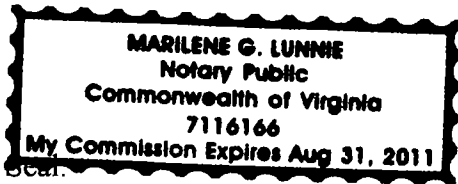


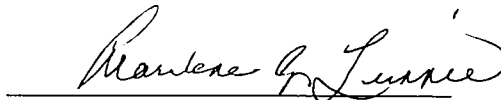

If you sign anywhere on the Registered Agent Combined Form, you agree that you understand that anyone who makes a false statement anywhere on it can be punished by criminal penalties of a fine up to \$1000, imprisonment up to 180 days, or both, under DCOC § 22-2405; and the corporation's certificate of authority can be denied or revoked.

RA-1. Registered Agent Written Consent
