## ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS IN ASSETS

Assignment made this 28 day of April, 2010, by E-Z Outdoor, LLC, and Indiana limited liability company, with offices in Evansville, Indiana ('Assignor'), to Old National Bank, a national banking association, with offices at One Main Street, Evansville, Indiana ("Assignee").

### RECITALS

A. Assignor has a vested interest in a certain new and useful improvement as more identified and described as the "Boat Mounted Blind", the technology of which is protected under U.S. Patent Registration No. 7,063,035 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the "Patent"); and Assignor further has a vested interest in the common law and registered name "E-Z BRUSH", Registration No. 3,153,043 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("Trademark").

B. Assignee desires to acquire an ownership interest in and to the Patent and Trademark.

1. Assignment.

In consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other value consideration, receipt of which is acknowledged by Assignor, Assignor assigns to Assignee One Hundred Percent (100%) ownership interest of Assignor's interest in the Patent and Trademark as heretofore defined.

2. Cooperation.

Assignor agrees to cooperate with Assignee such that Assignee may enjoy to the fullest extent the rights conveyed hereunder. Included within the scope of the duties is cooperation in such proceedings involving the United States and foreign applications and patents as opposition, cancellation proceedings, priority contest, public use proceedings, court actions, and the like.

3. Parties.

The terms and provisions of this Assignment shall inure to the benefit of Assignee, its successors, and/or other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon the Assignor, its heirs and legal representatives.

4. Warranty.

Assignor warrants and represents that it has not entered into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.
