17 This matter having come before the on Plaintiff's Motion and Affidavit for Judgment
18 by Default, pursuant to Rule 55(b)(1) Ariz. R.Civ.P., and the Court finding:

20 1. That Defendant ReGen Biologics, Inc. was regularly and duly served with the
21 Summons and Complaint, and that its time to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint
22 has expired and it has made no "appearance" in this case.

24 2. That all default procedures were complied with and that the default of
25 Defendant ReGen Biologics, Inc. has been duly and properly entered and is now effective.

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27 3. That there is no just reason for delay and that final judgment should be
28 entered pursuant to Rule 54(b), Ariz.R.Civ.P.

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Based upon the foregoing findings, and good cause appearing therefor;

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Off Madison Ave., Inc., be awarded Judgment against Defendant ReGen Biologics, Inc., as follows:


A. In the principal amount of \$26,862.22, plus prejudgment interest accrued and owing as of February 28, 2010, in the amount of \$1,088.70 and continuing to accrue at 10%, which equals \$7.66 per day after February 28, 2010, until paid in full;

B. For Plaintiff's taxable costs in the amount of \$346.00, together with interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent (10%) per annum from the date of judgment until paid in full;

C. For such other and further accruing costs and fees incurred in the collection of this judgment, including pre and post judgment interest thereon from the date of judgment at the rate of ten percent (10%) per annum until paid in full;

D. Confirming that all such relief is awarded without prejudice to Plaintiff's right to pursue declaratory judgment relief in this matter at a later time.
